FTE set to 1.0 for students in the MED career, including MD, visiting MD, and medical residents. Student level Specialist included with Masters.

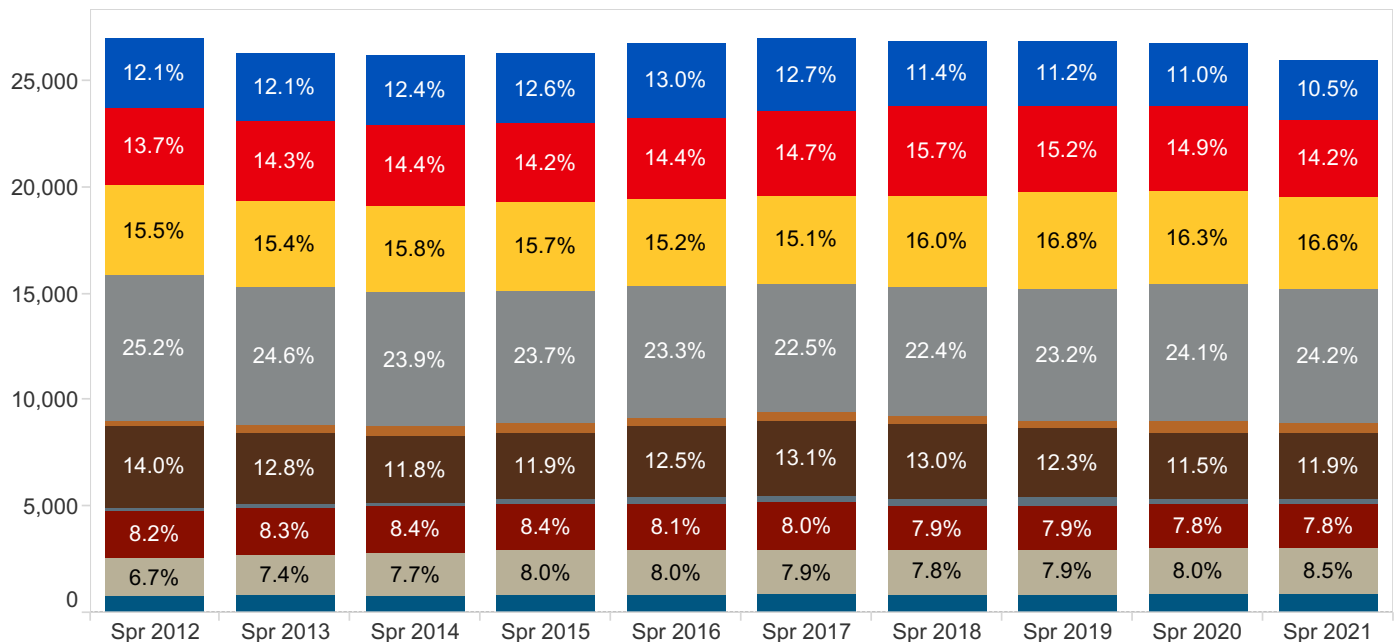

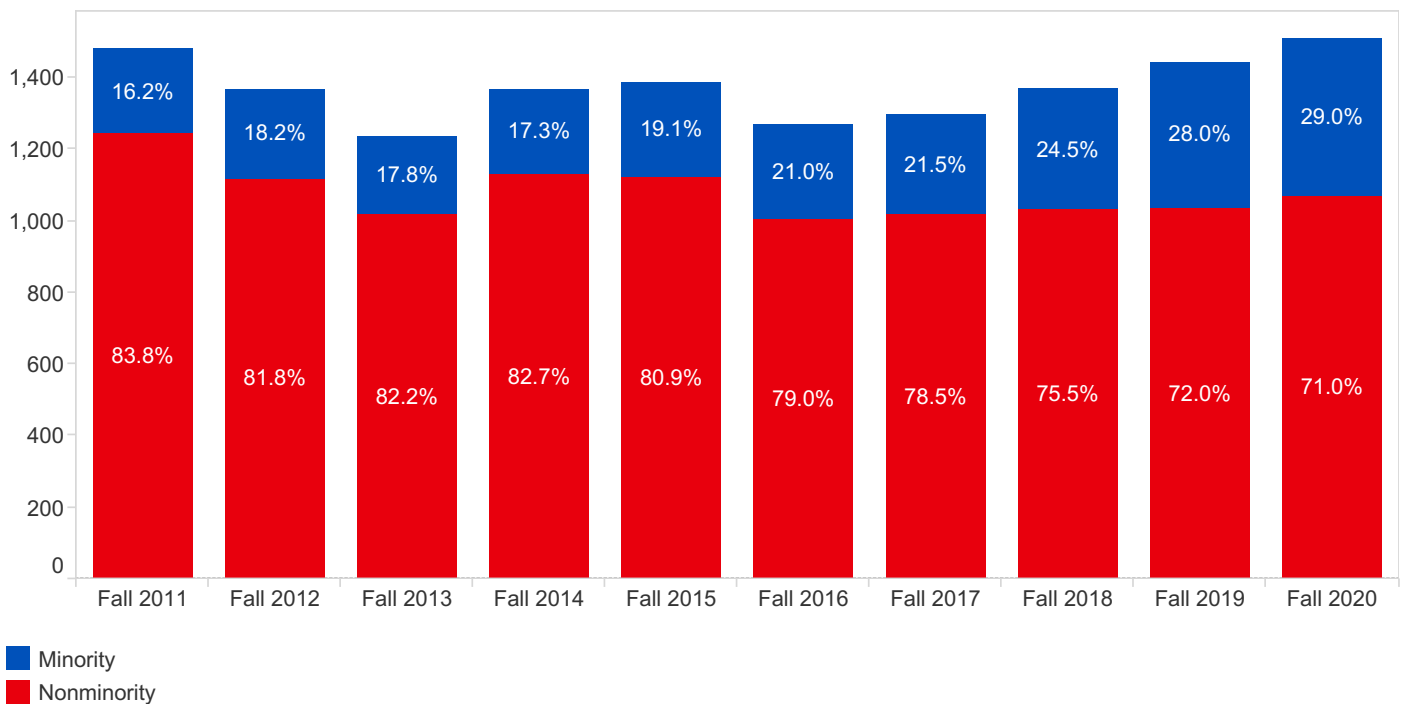

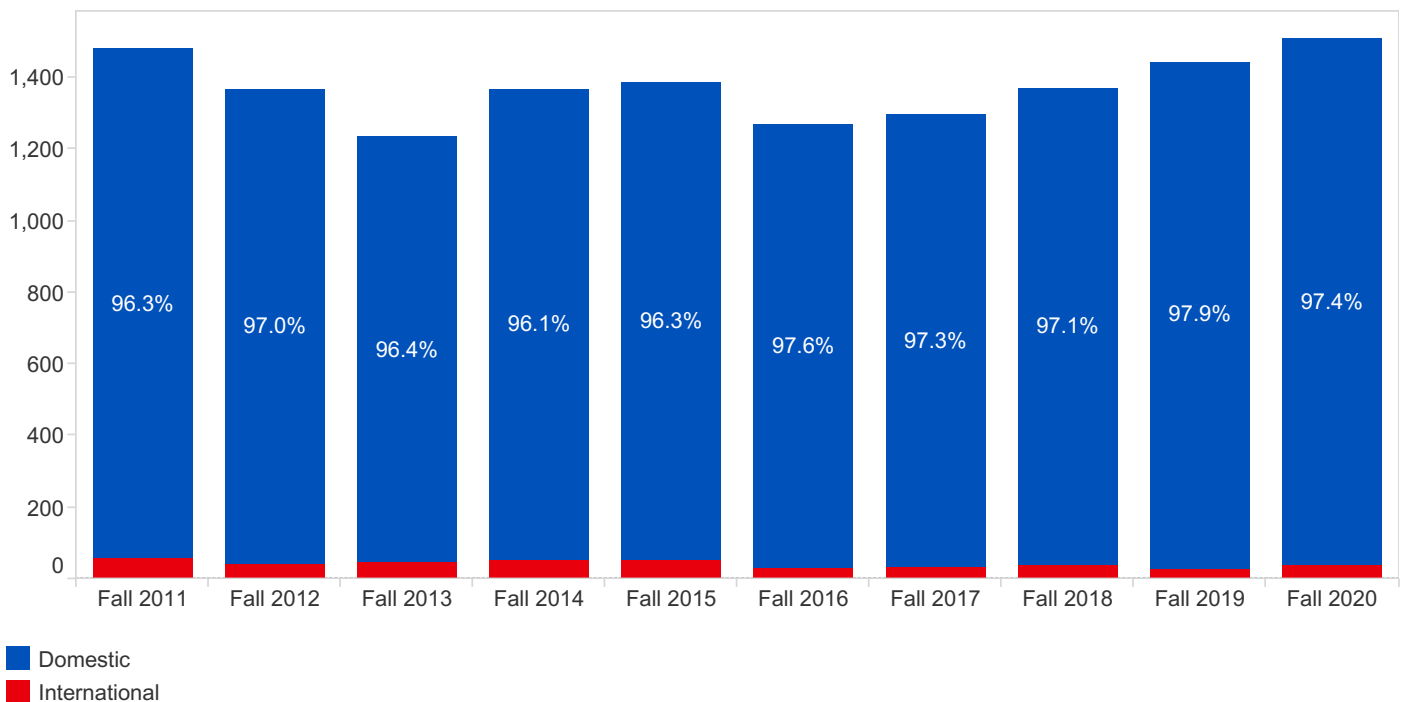

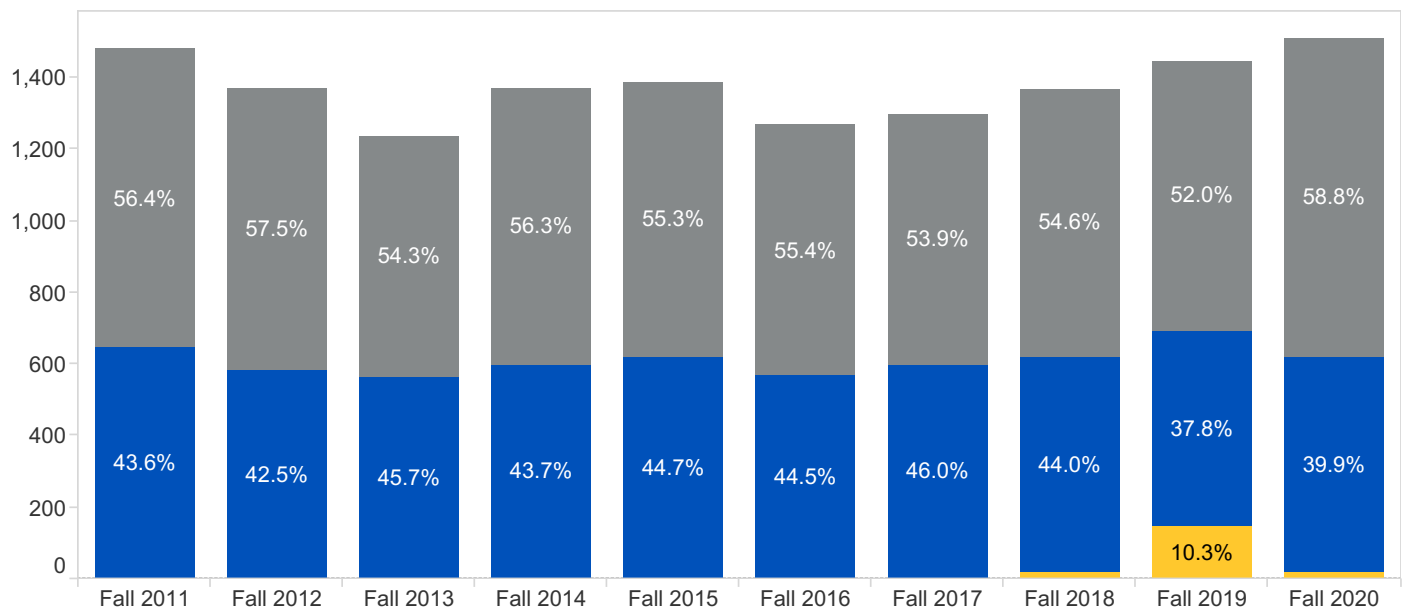

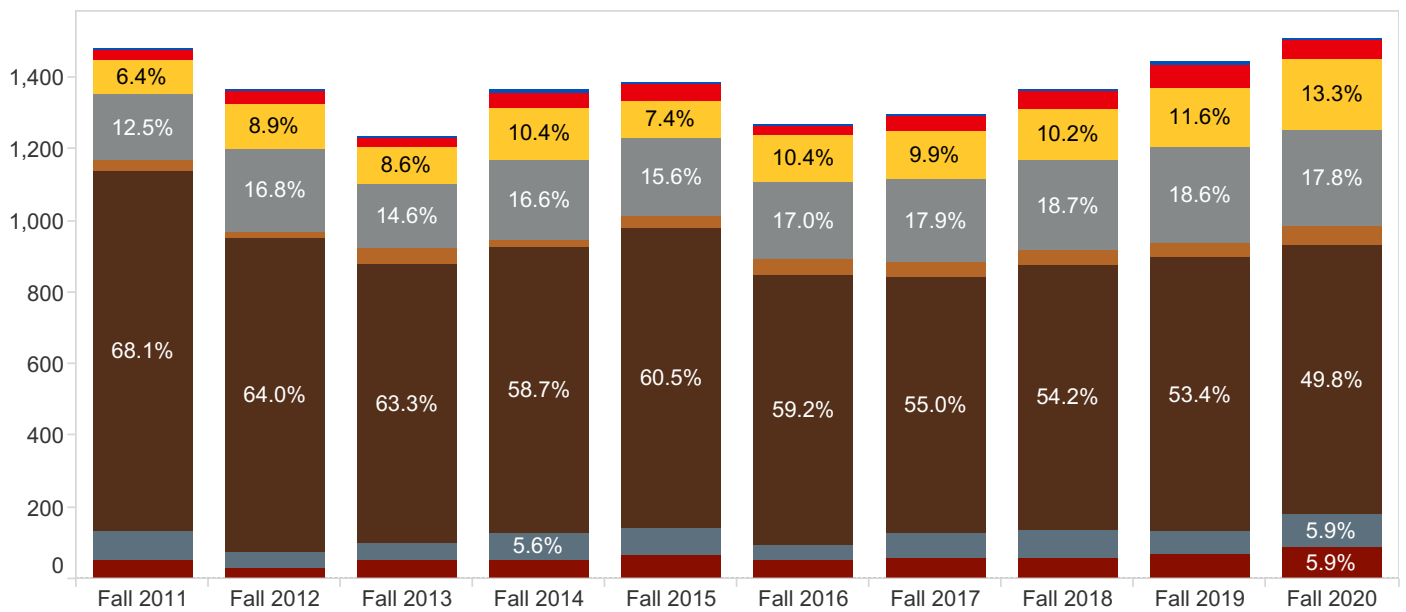

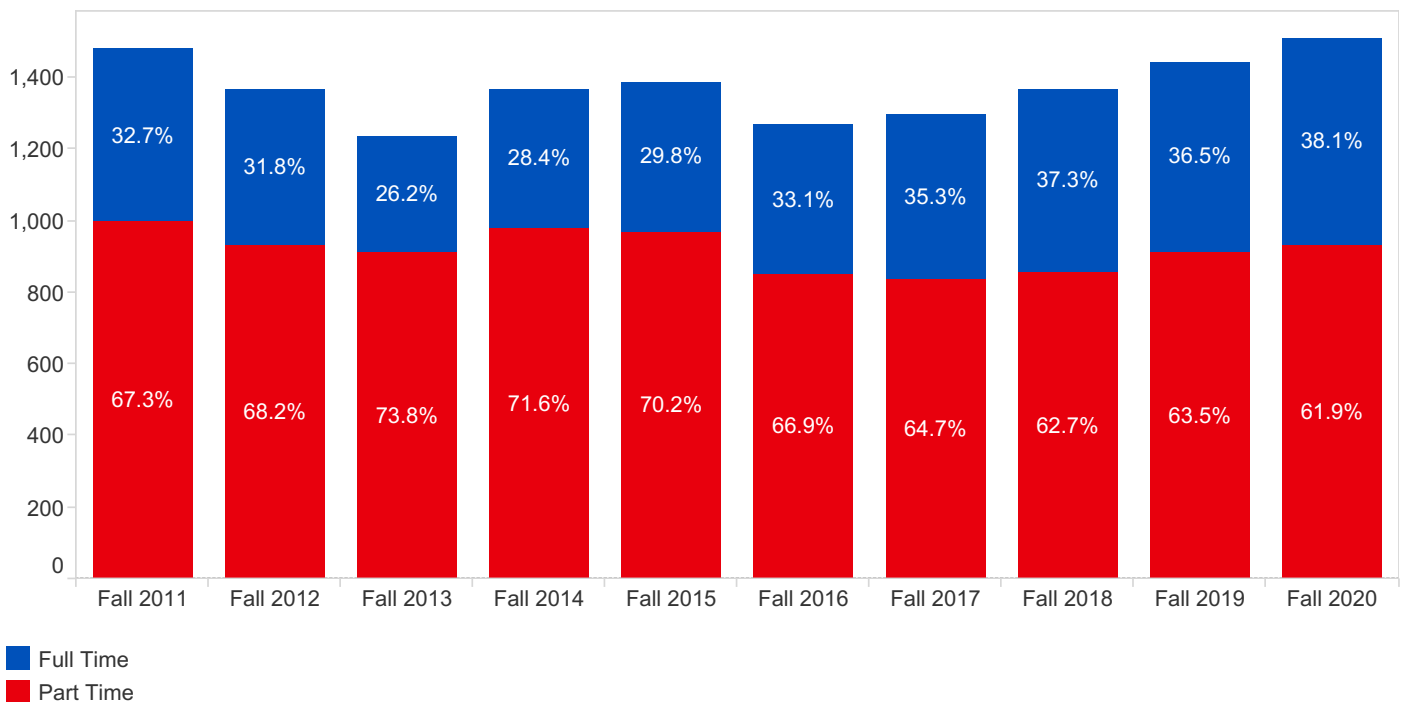

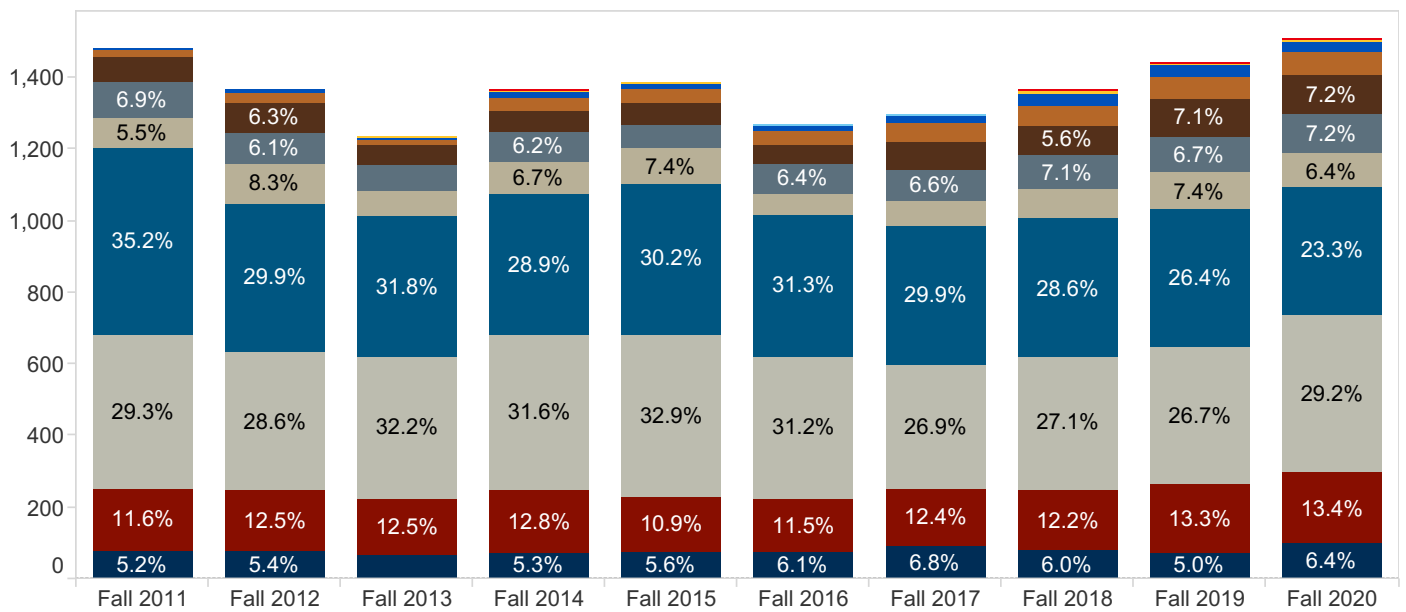

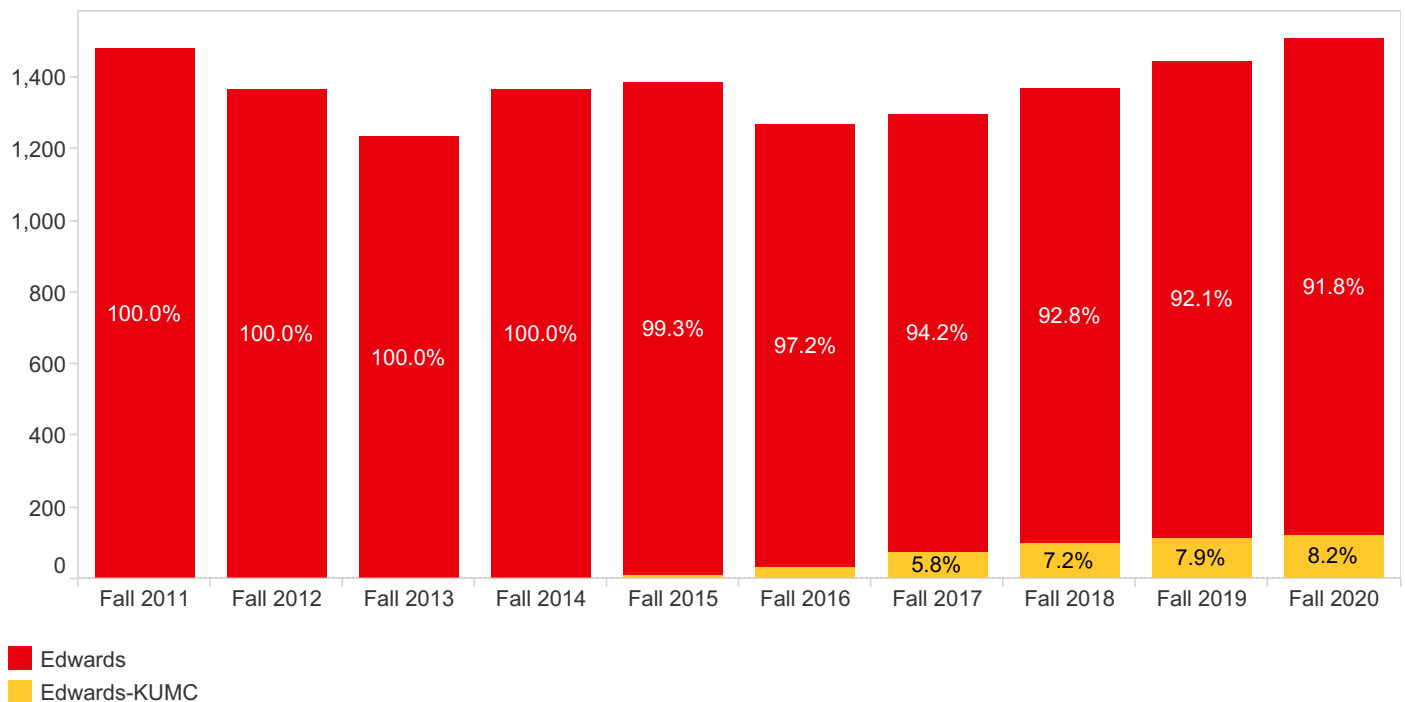

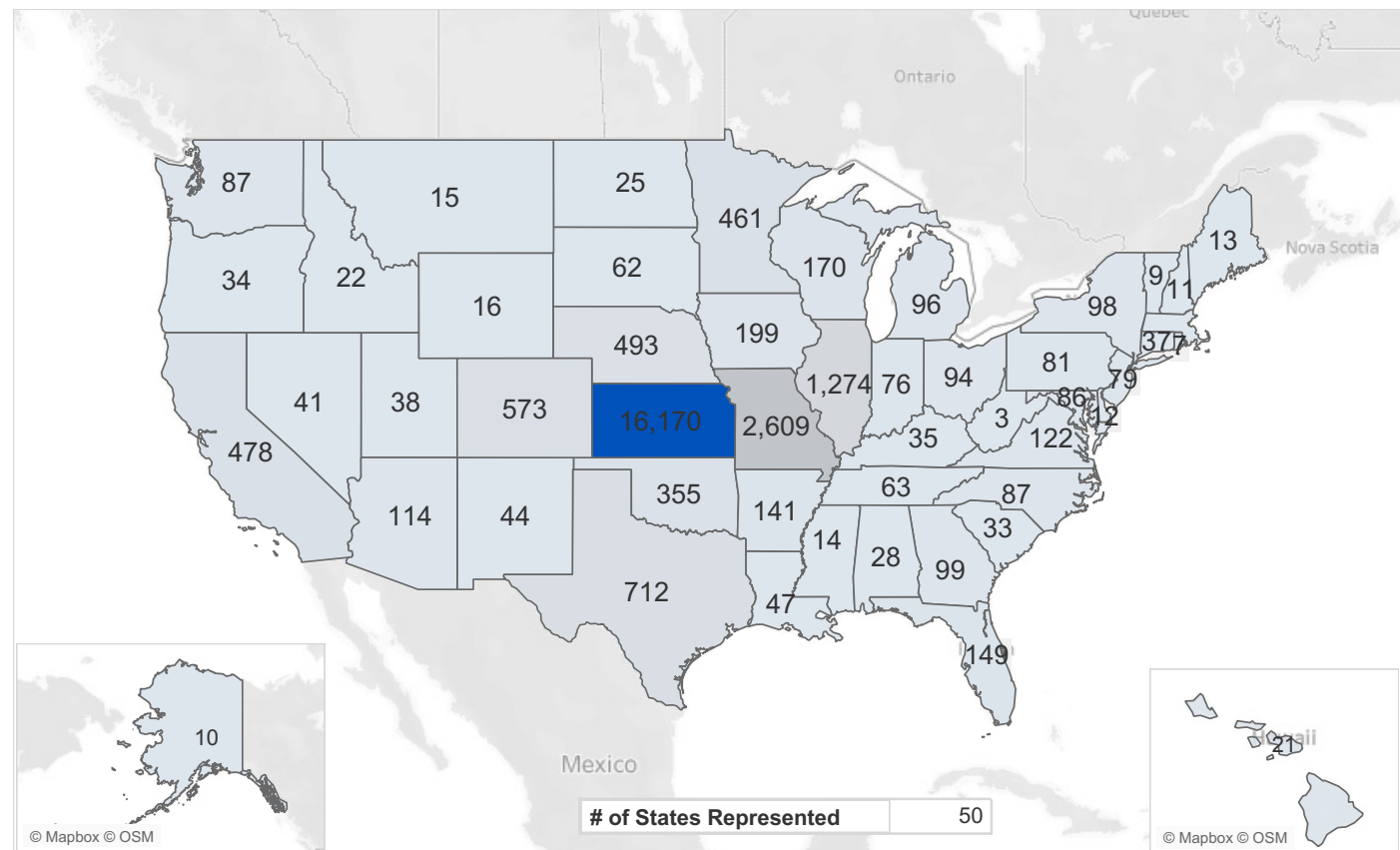

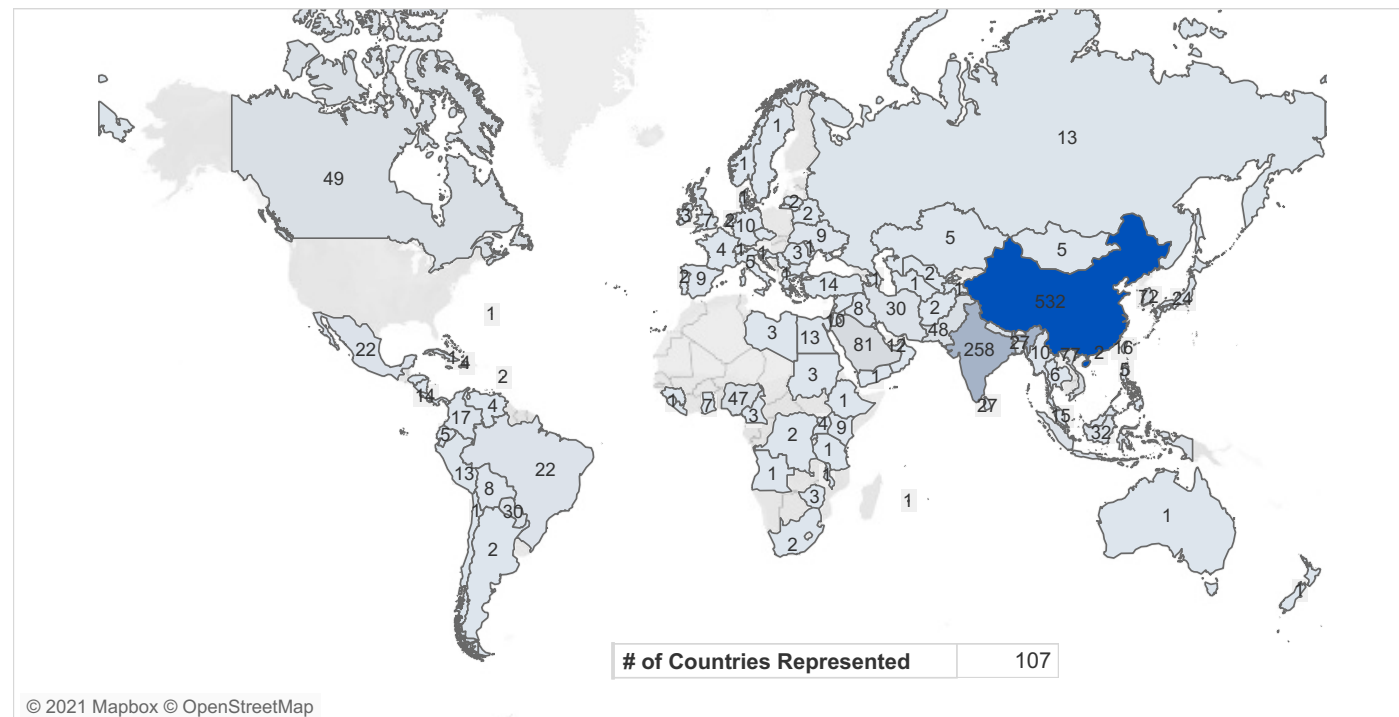

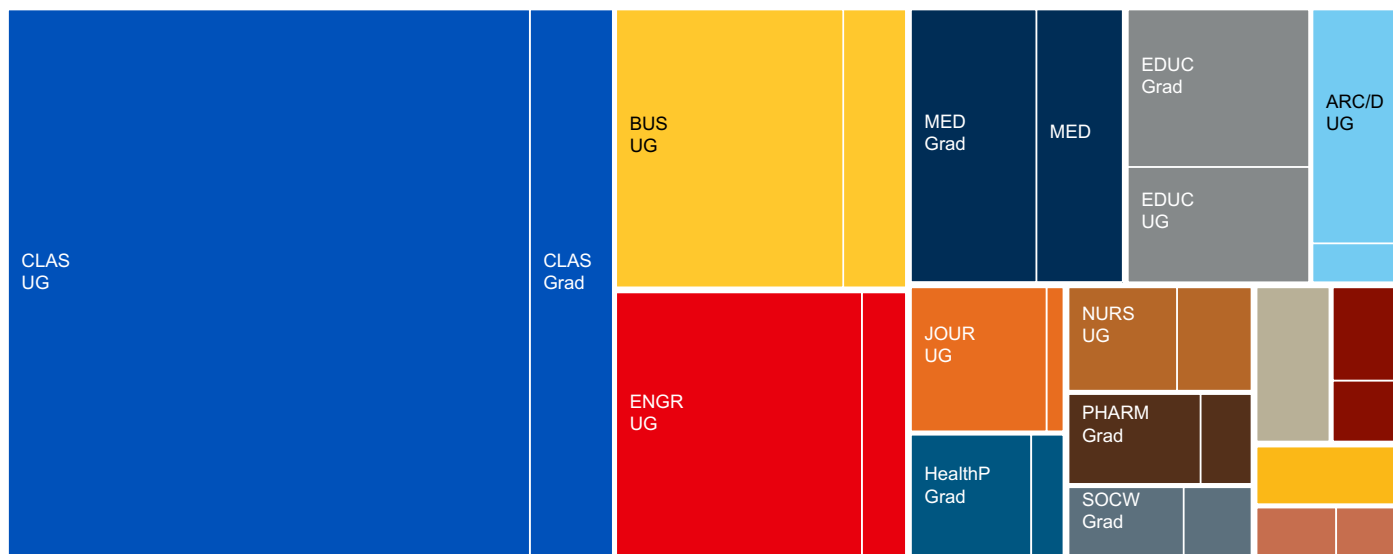

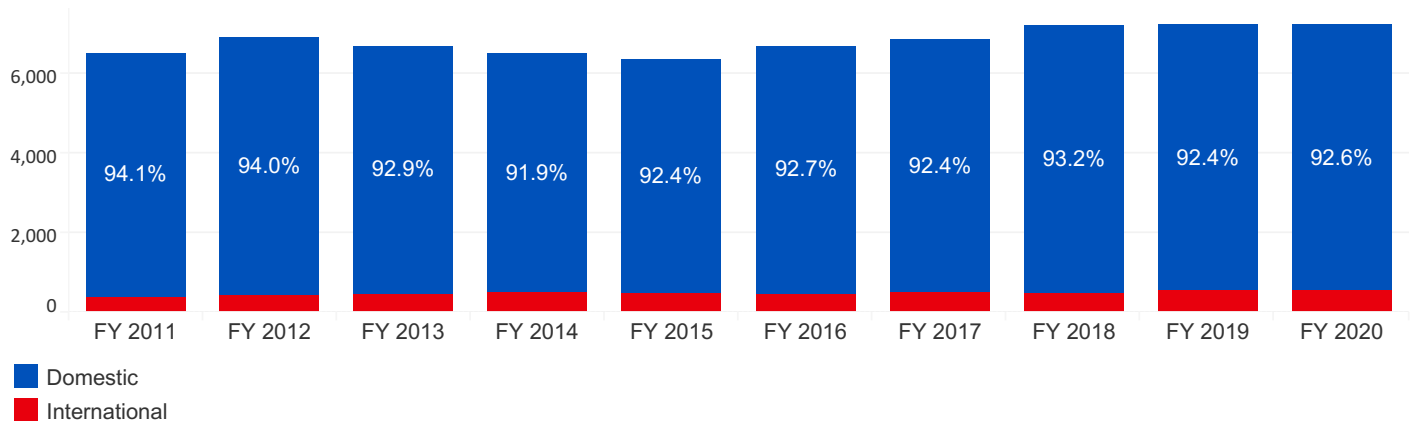

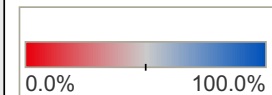

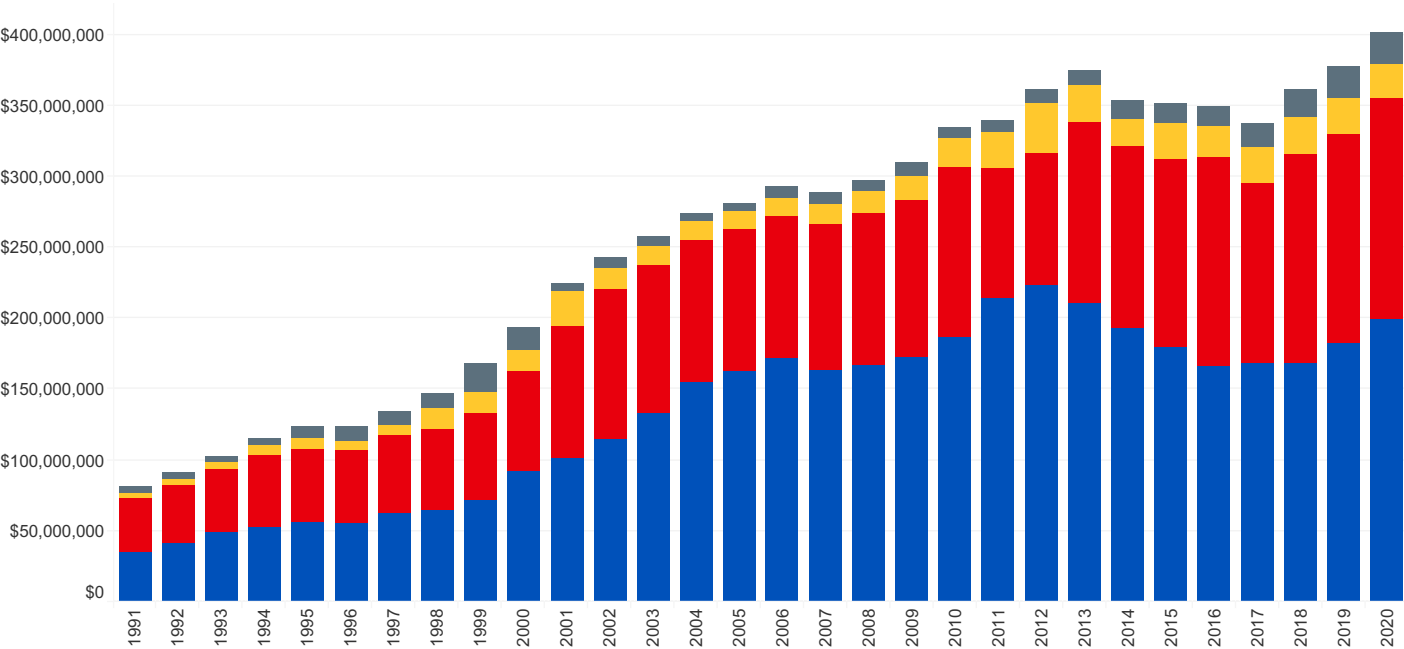

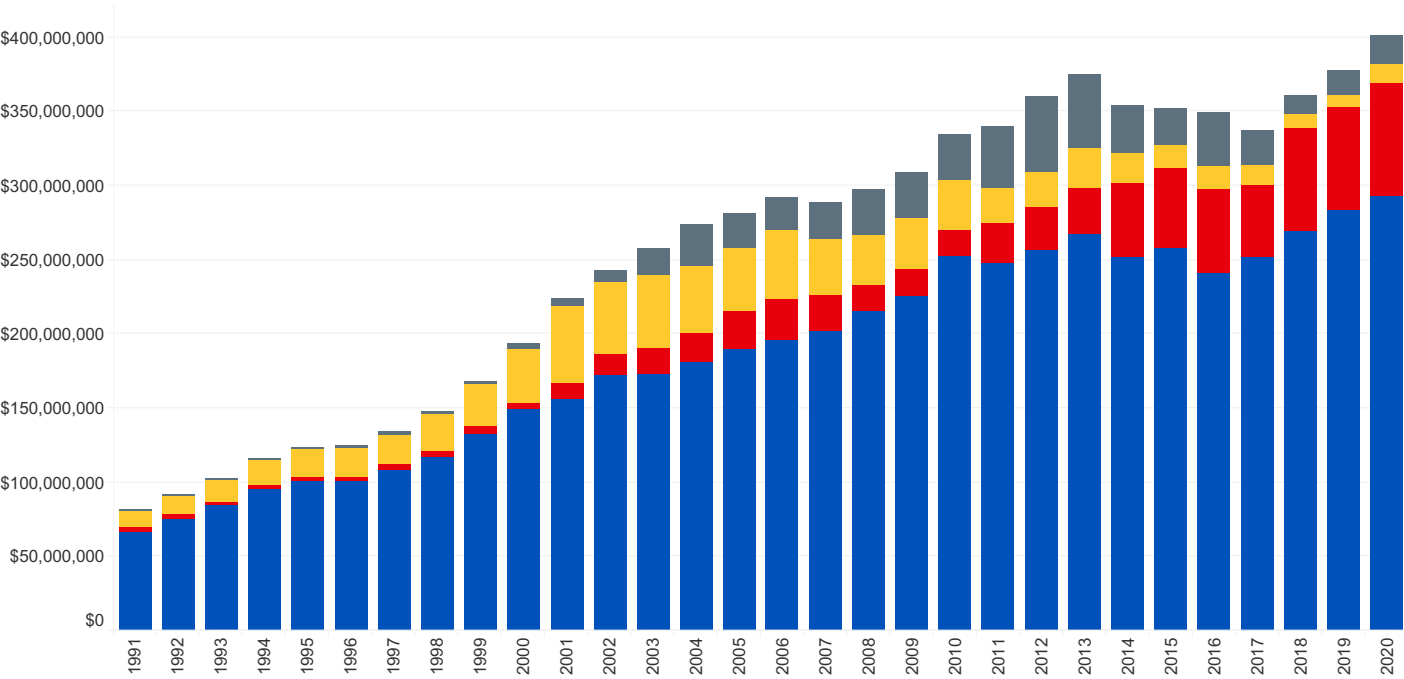

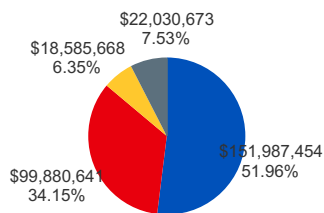

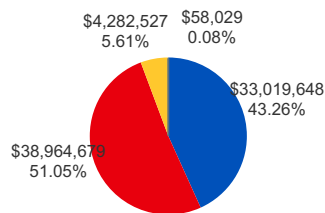

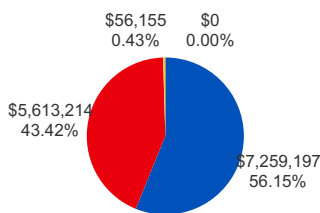
Science Research Expenditures by Funding Source



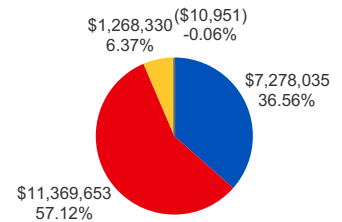
Nonscience Research Expenditures by Funding Source

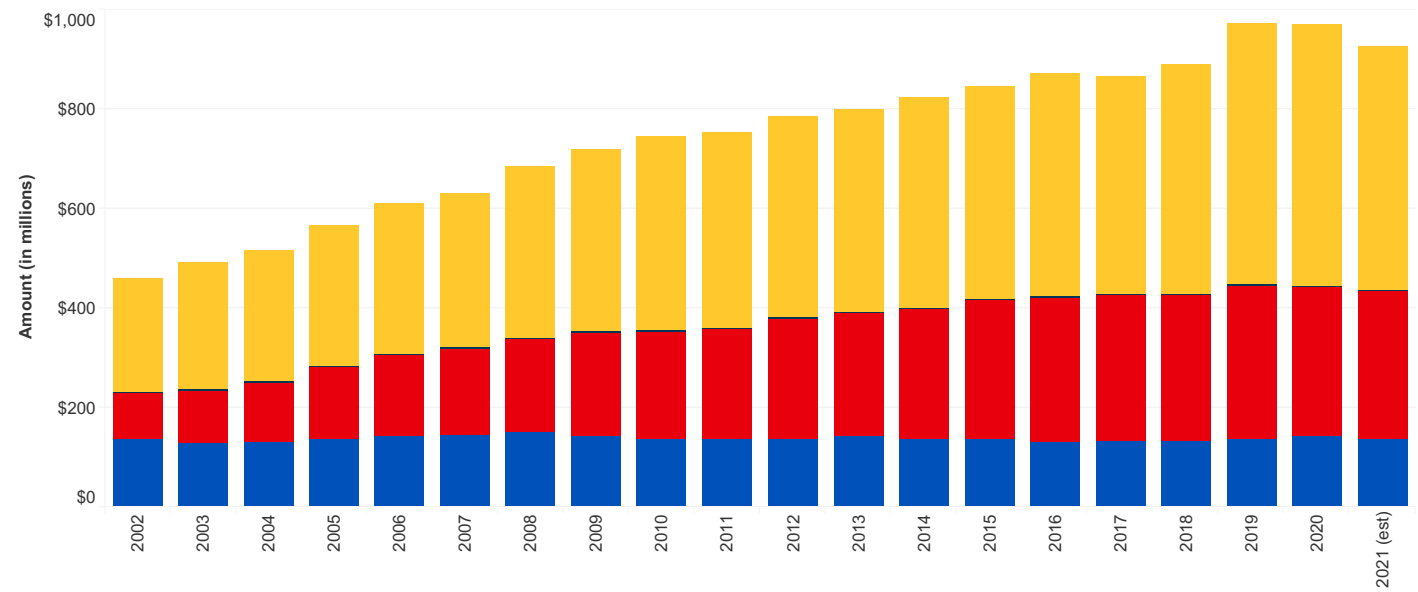

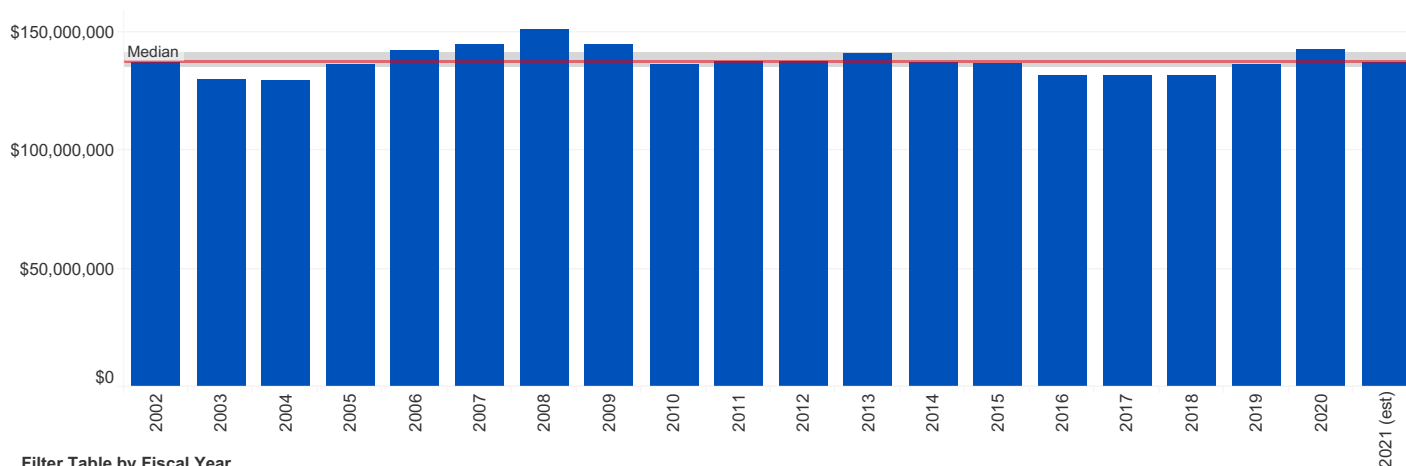

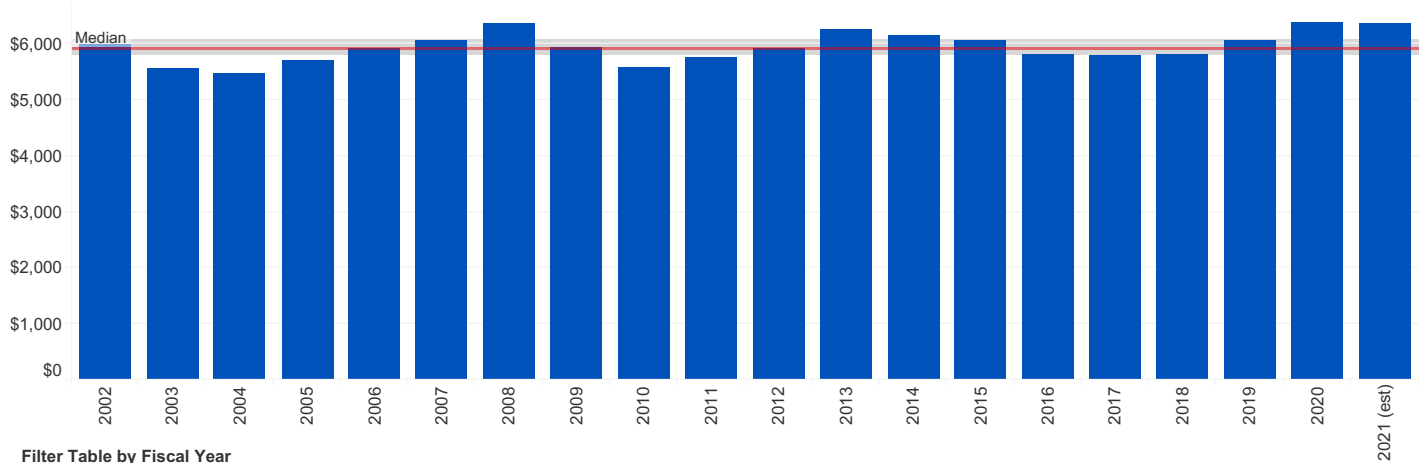

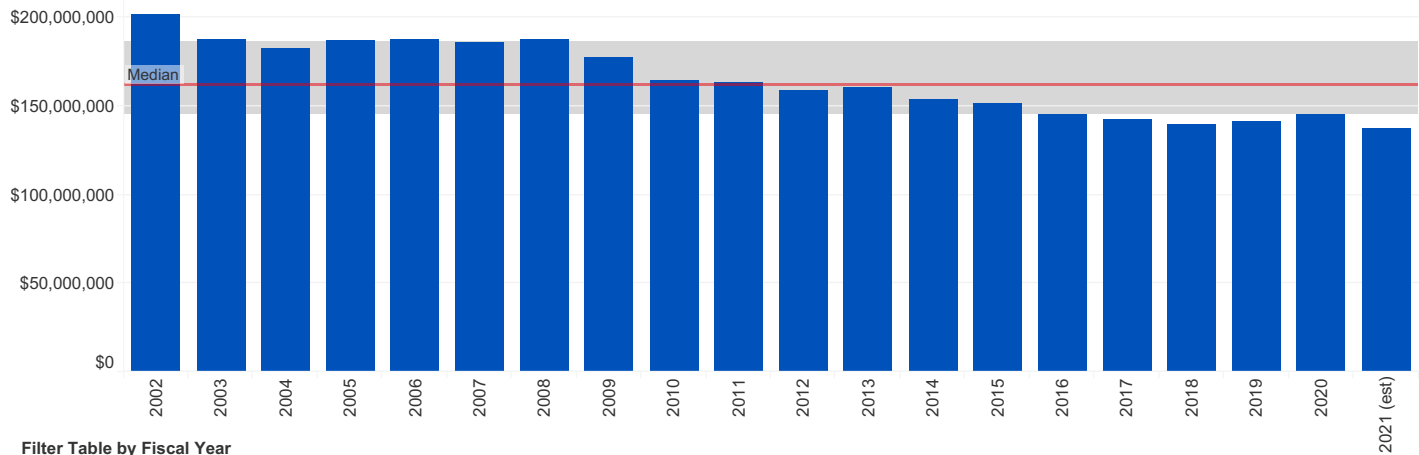

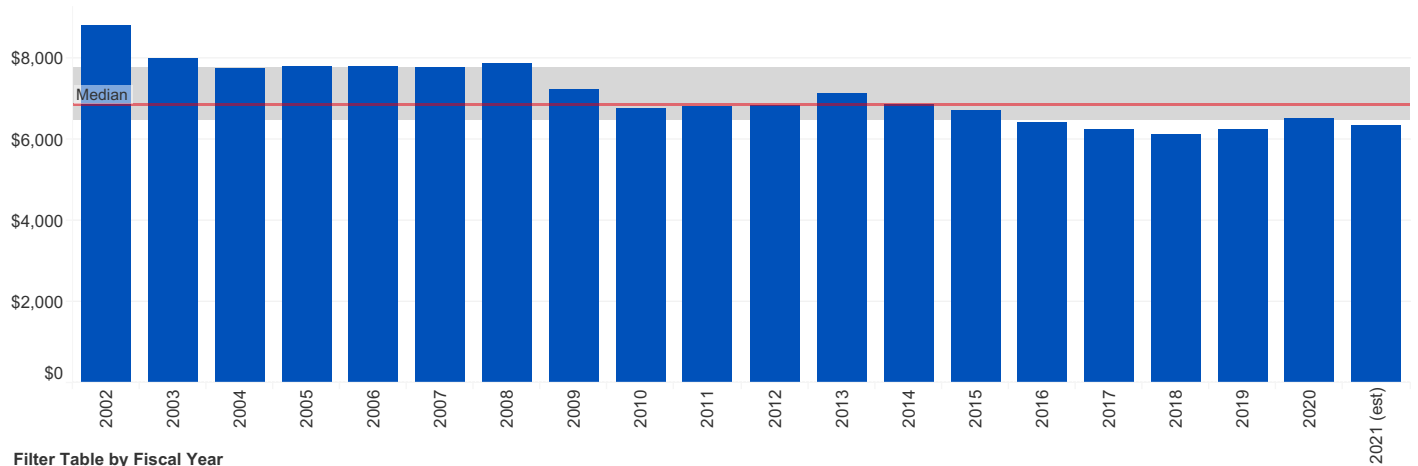

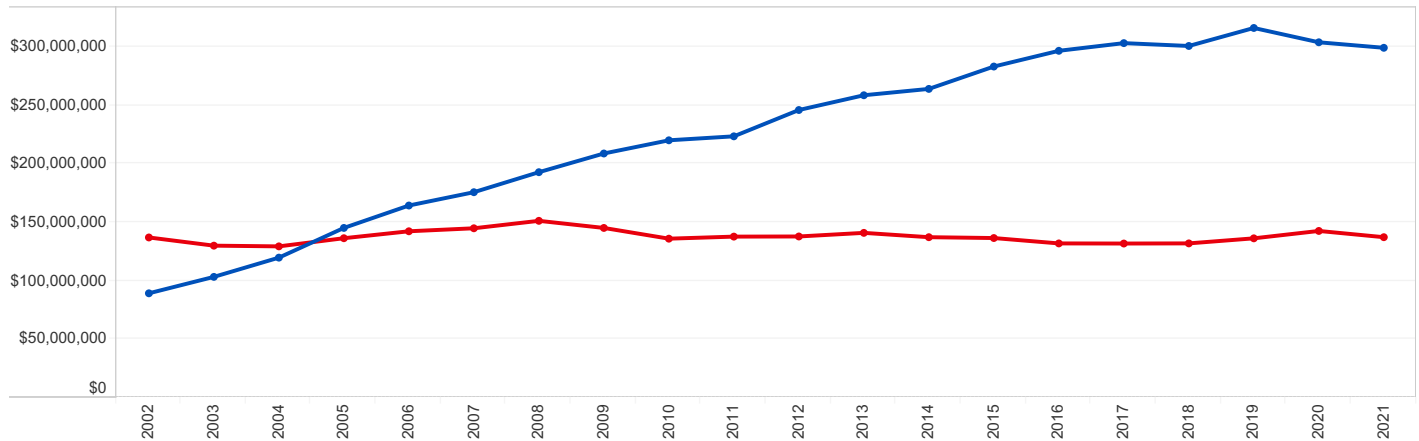

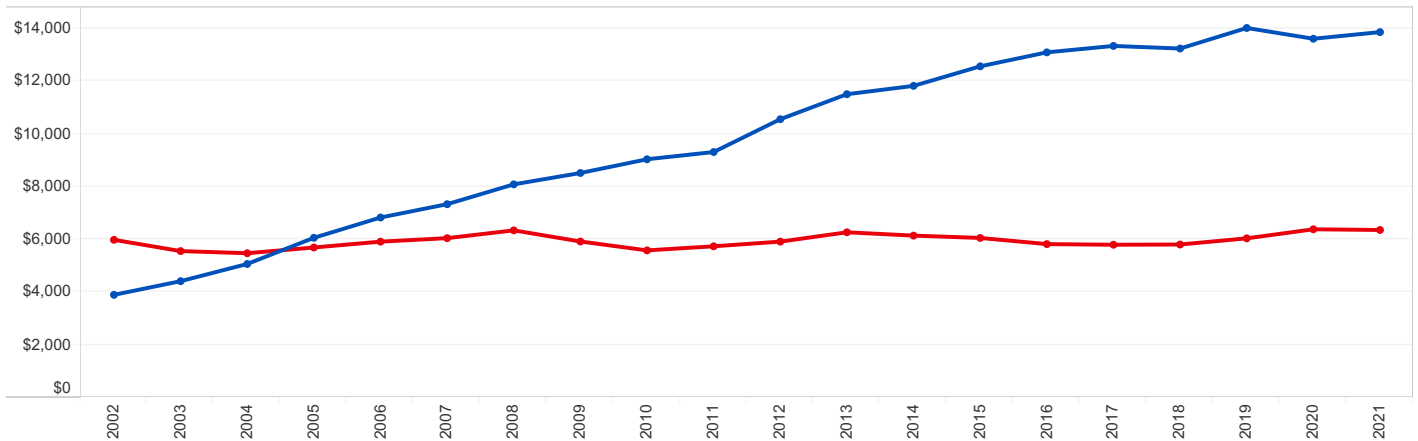

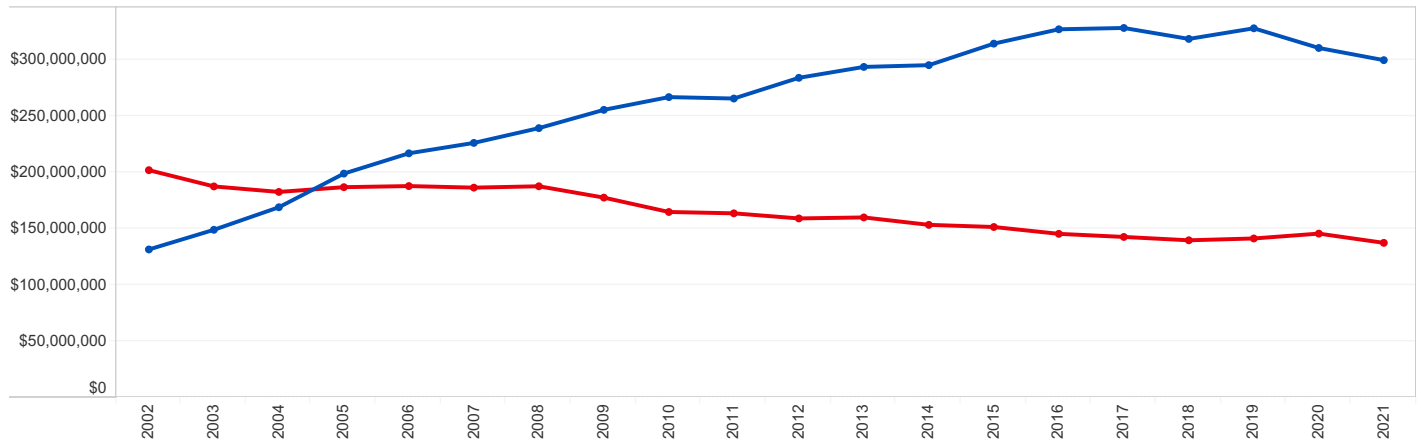

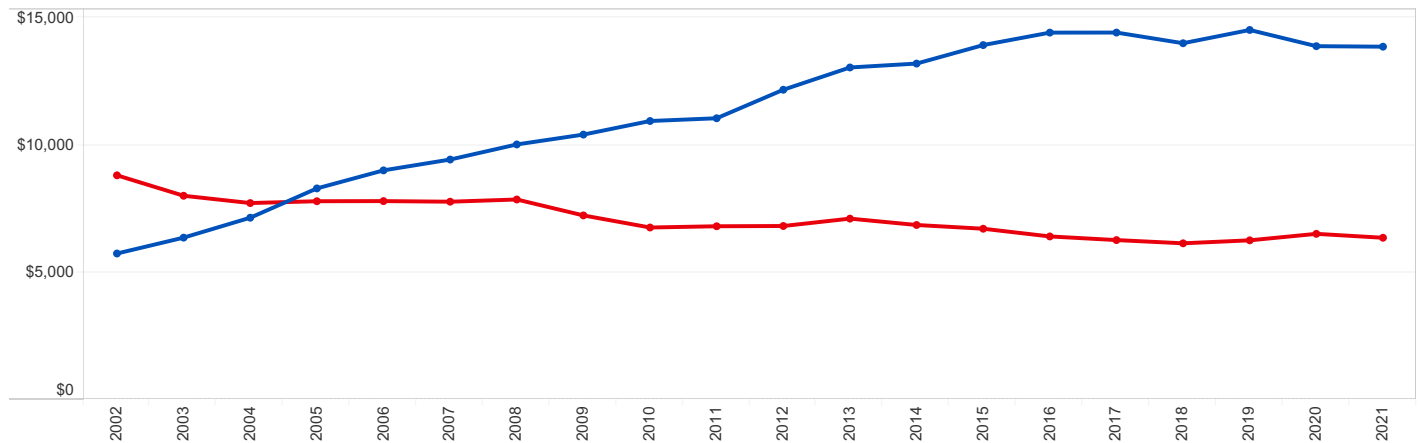
