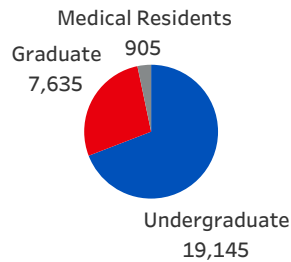

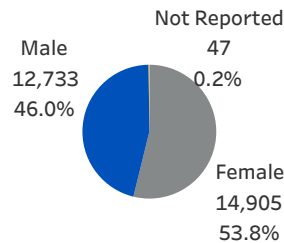

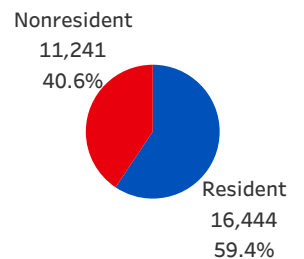

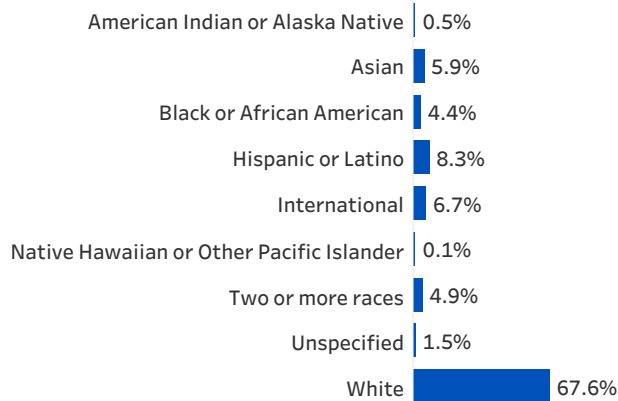

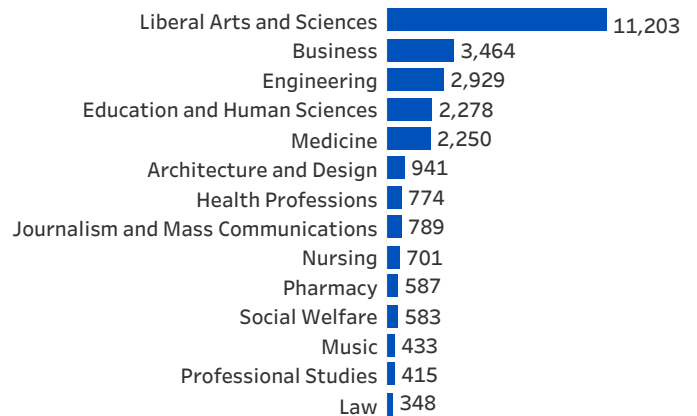

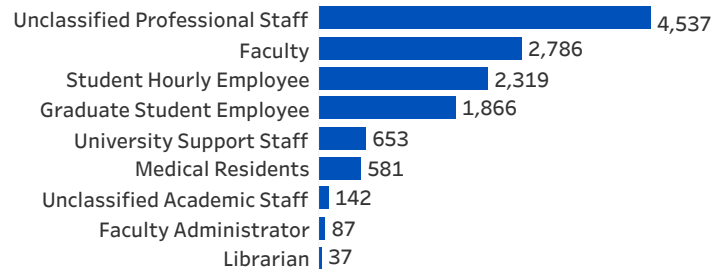

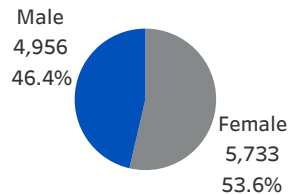

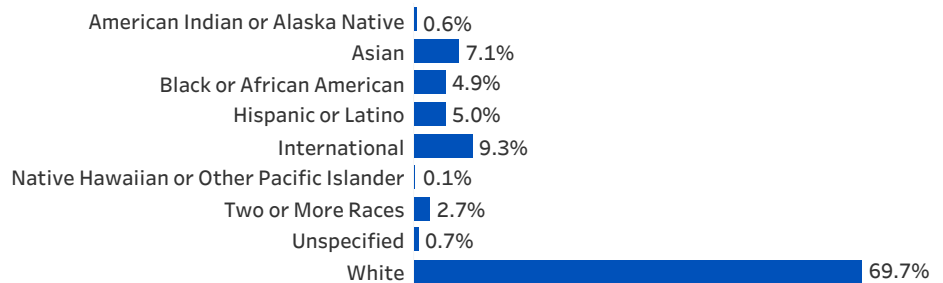

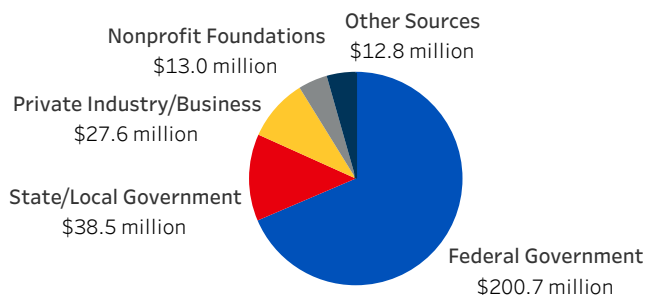

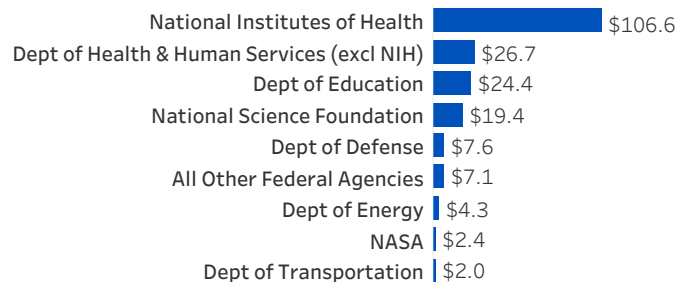

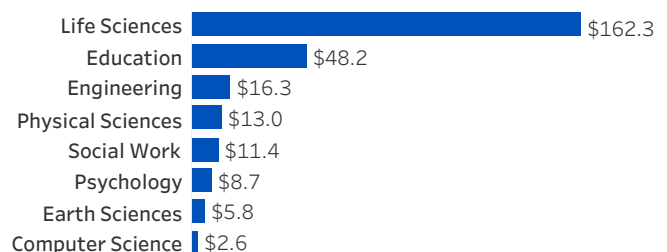
Research Expenditures by Funding Source

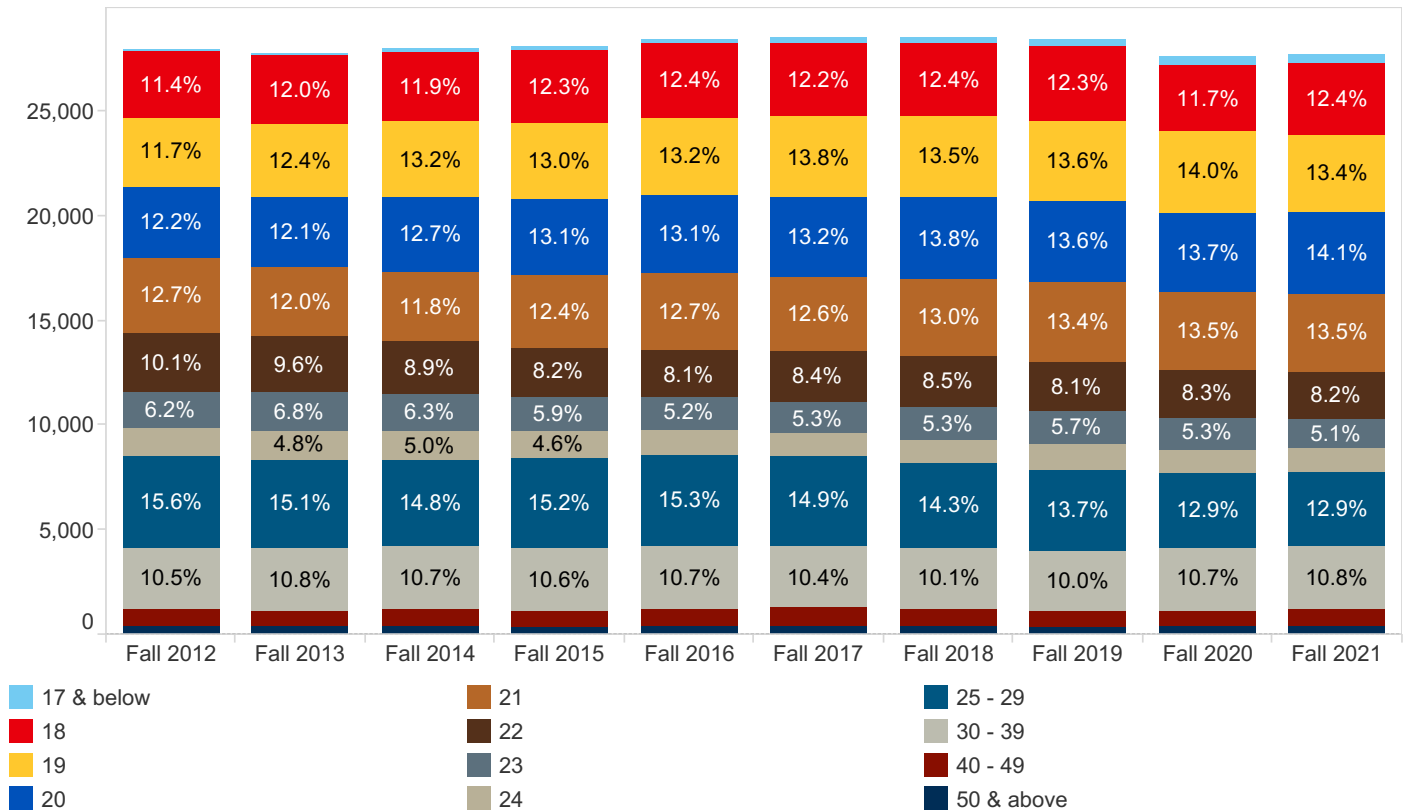

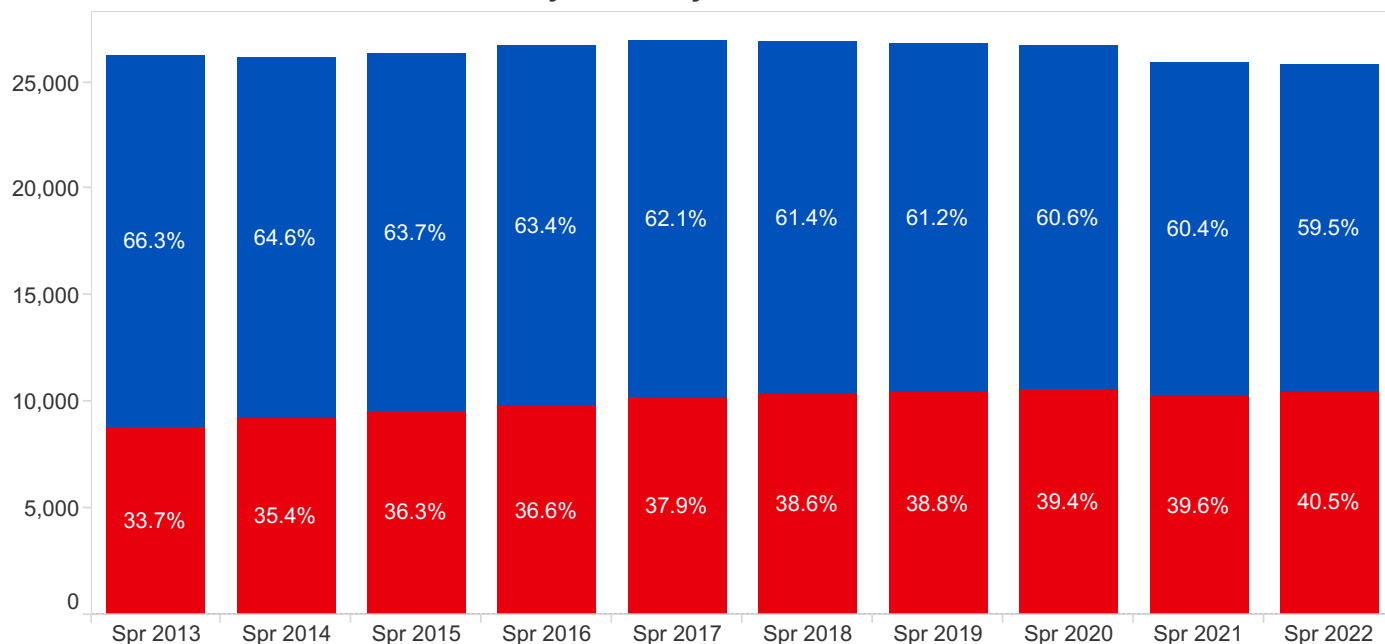

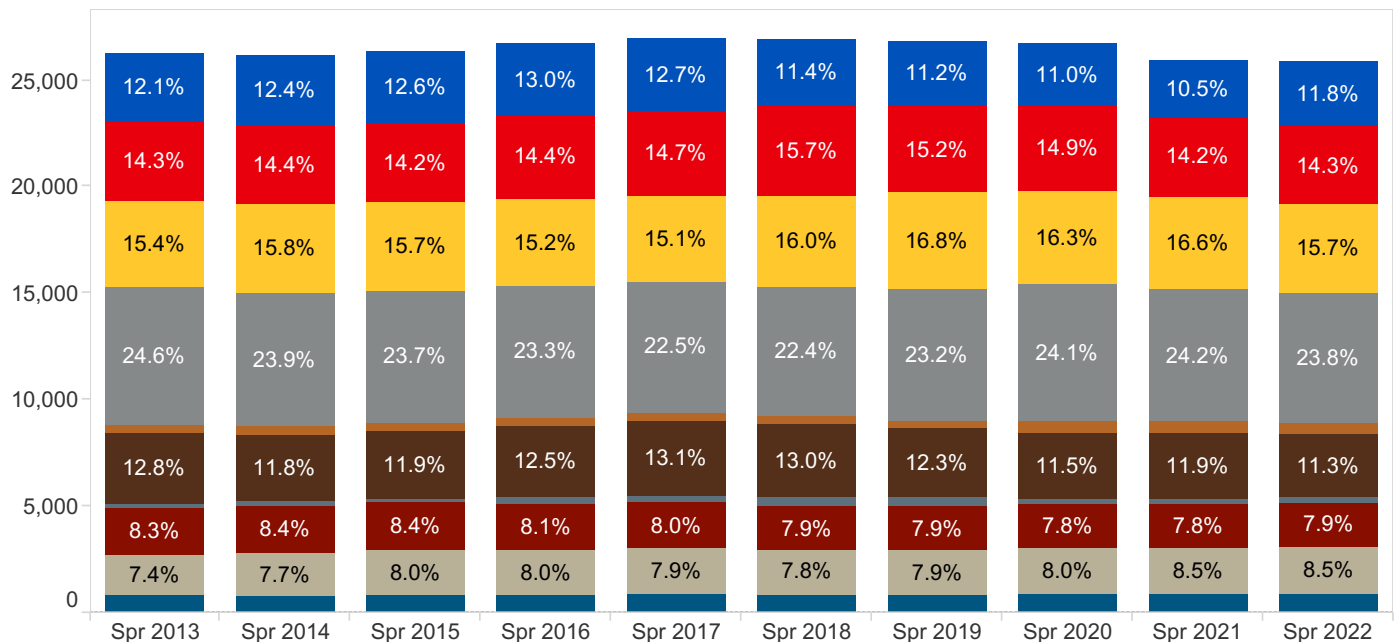

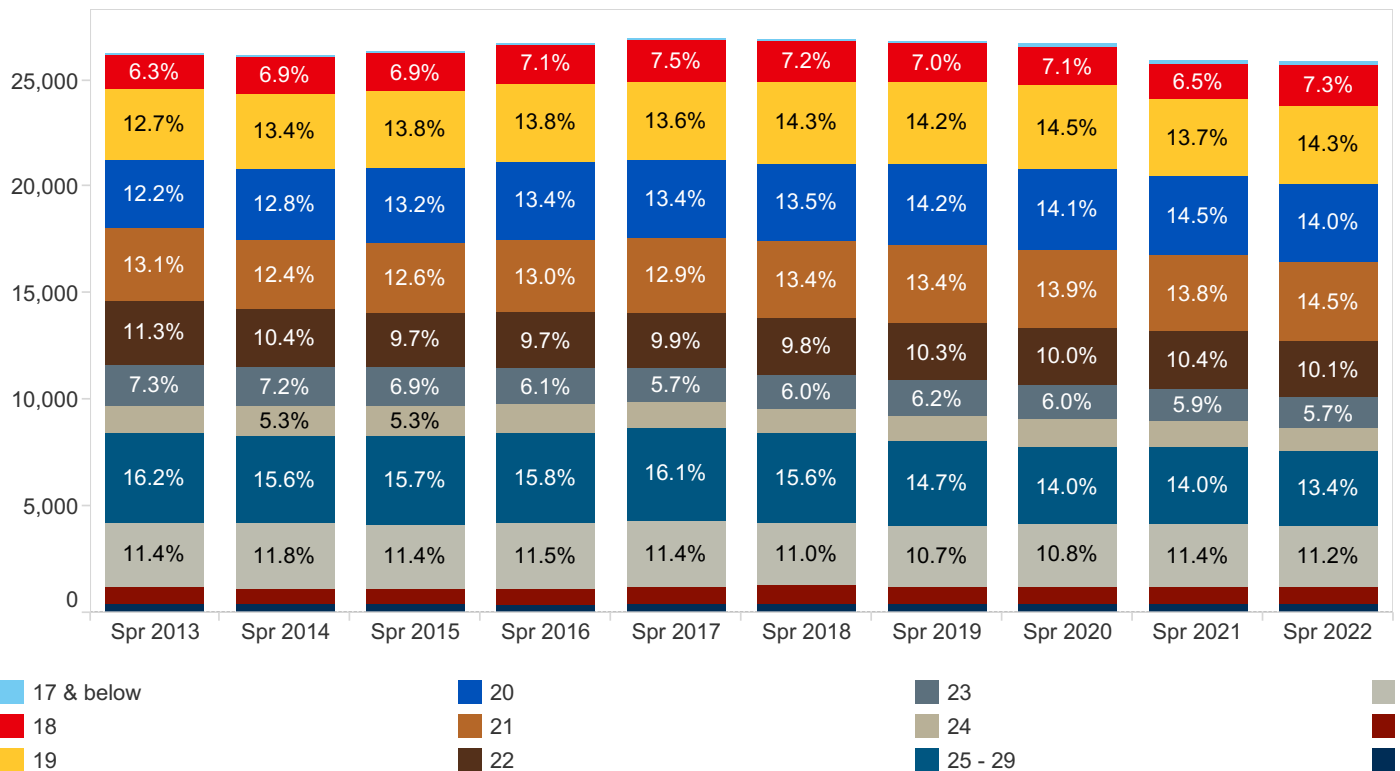

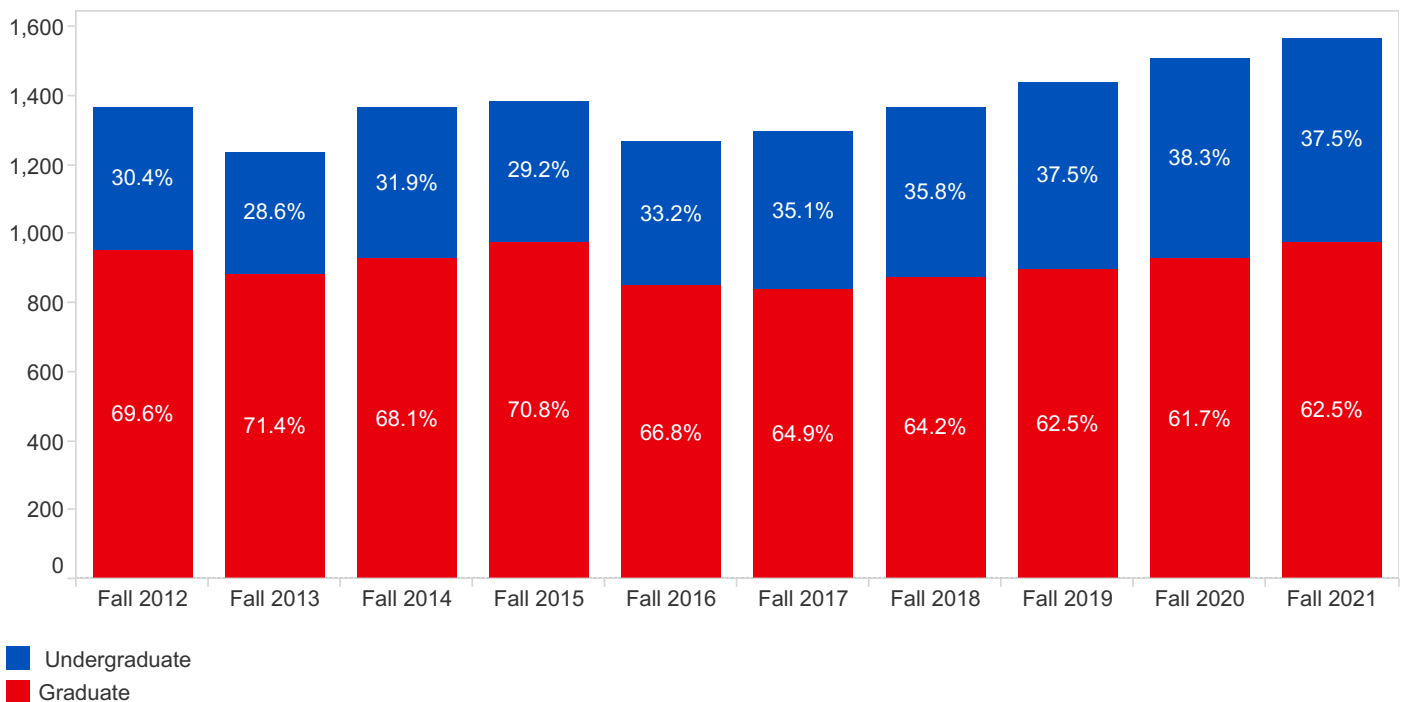

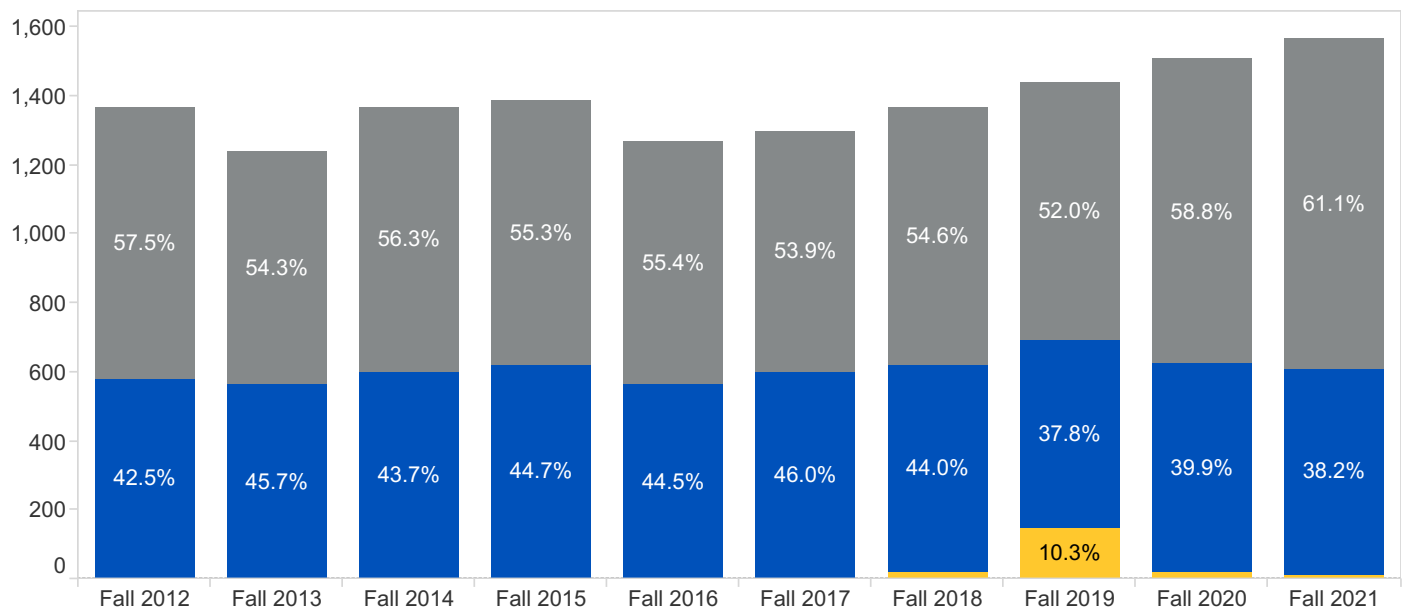

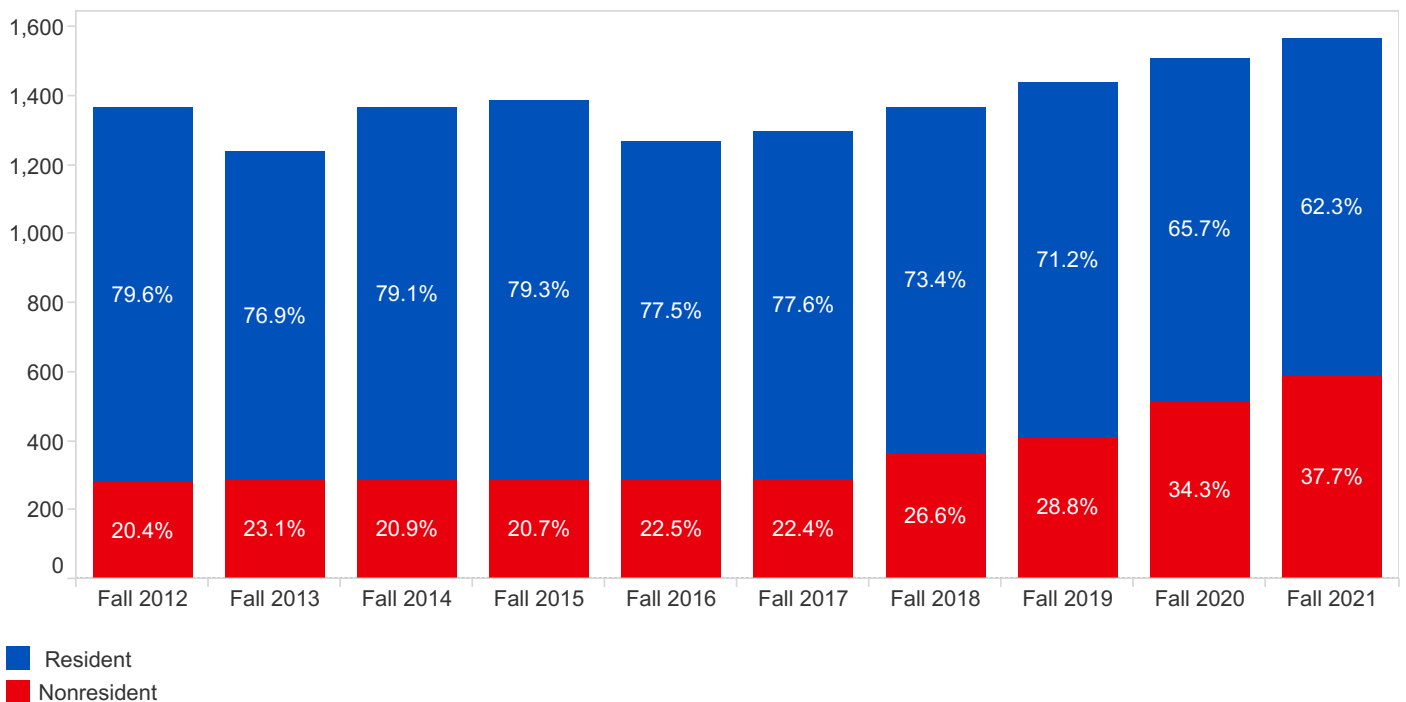

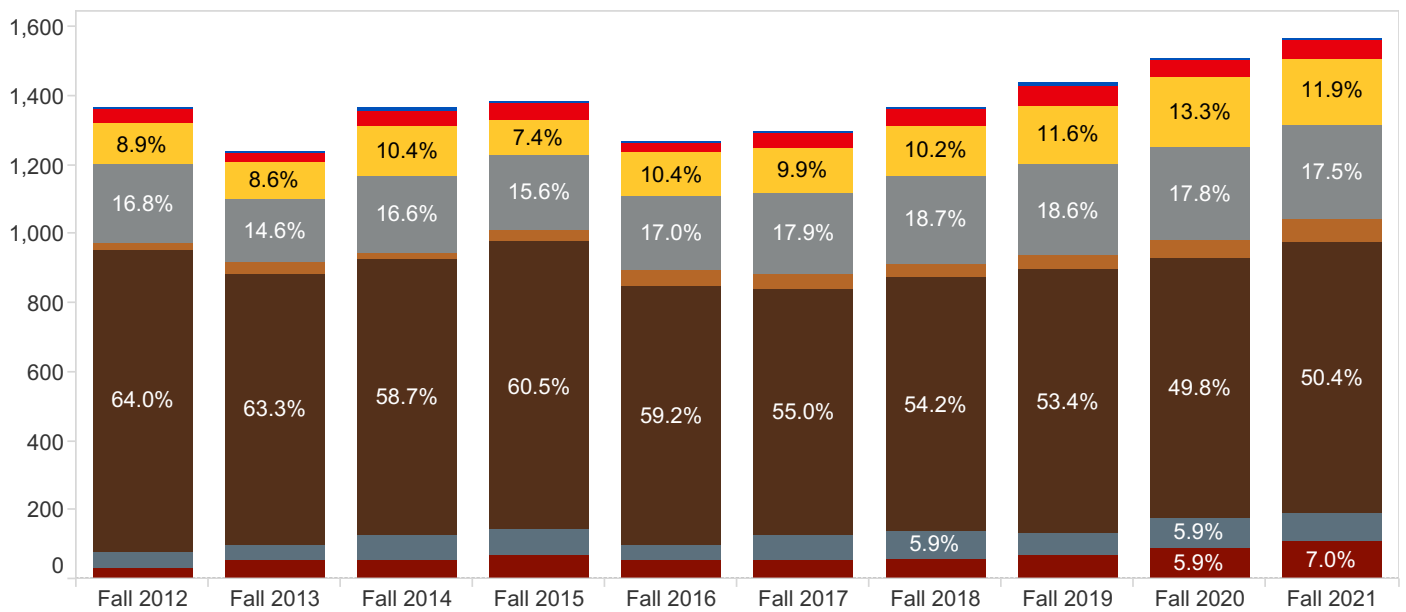

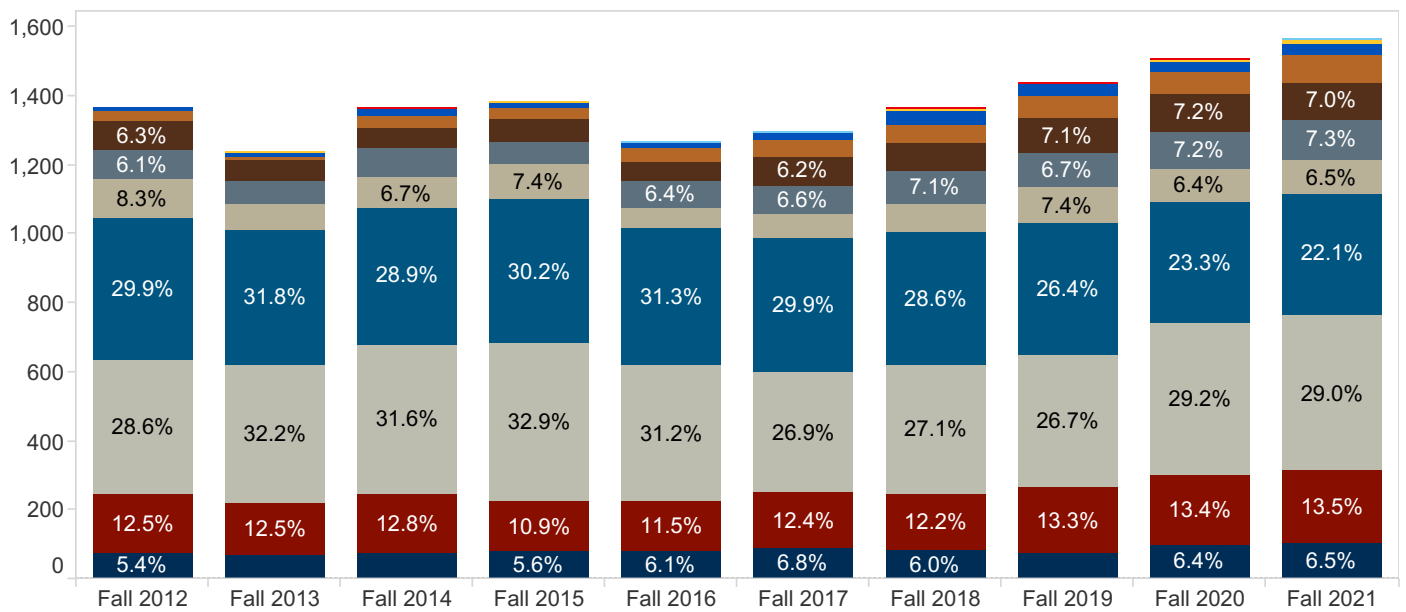

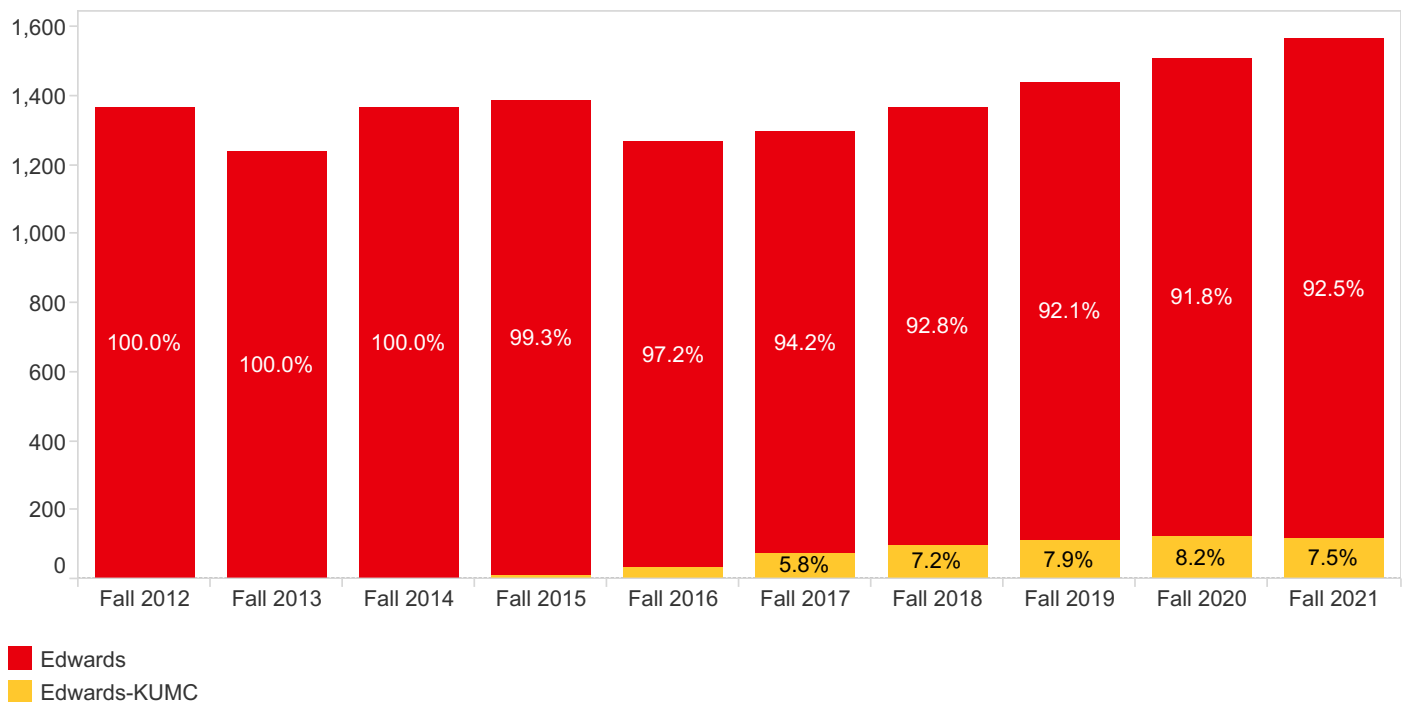

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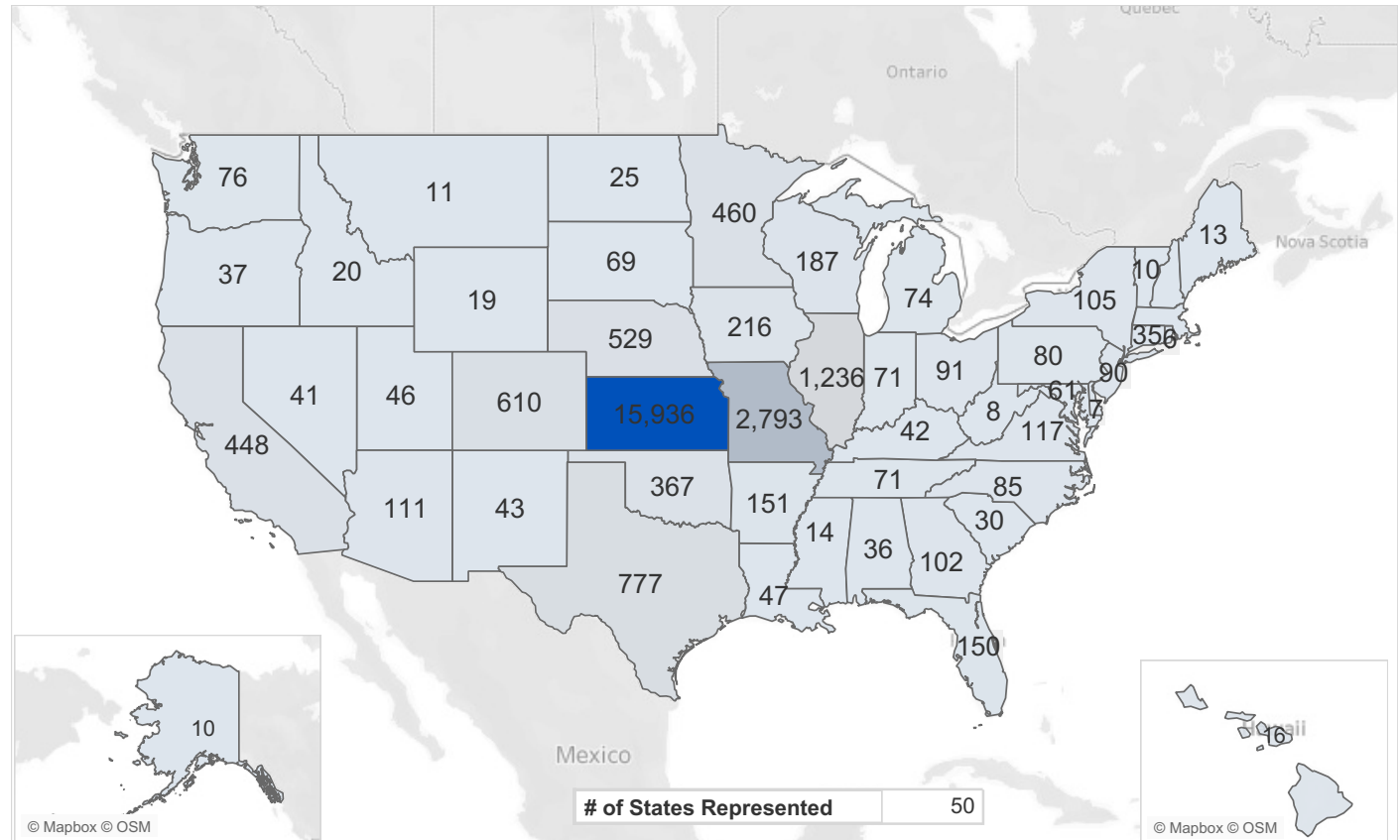

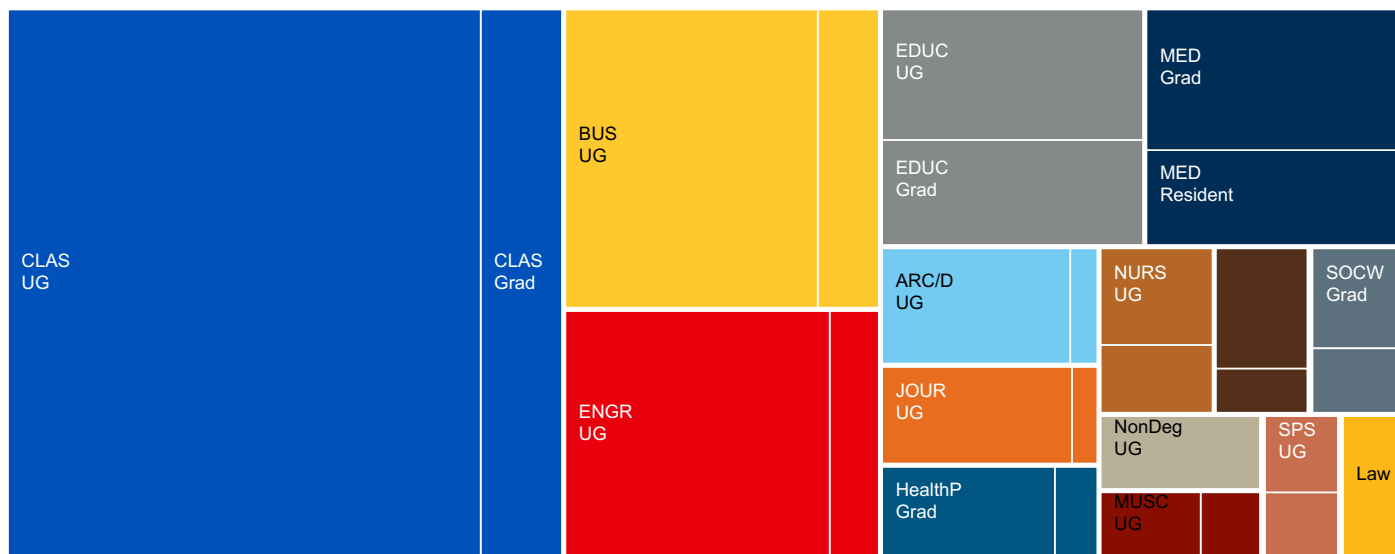

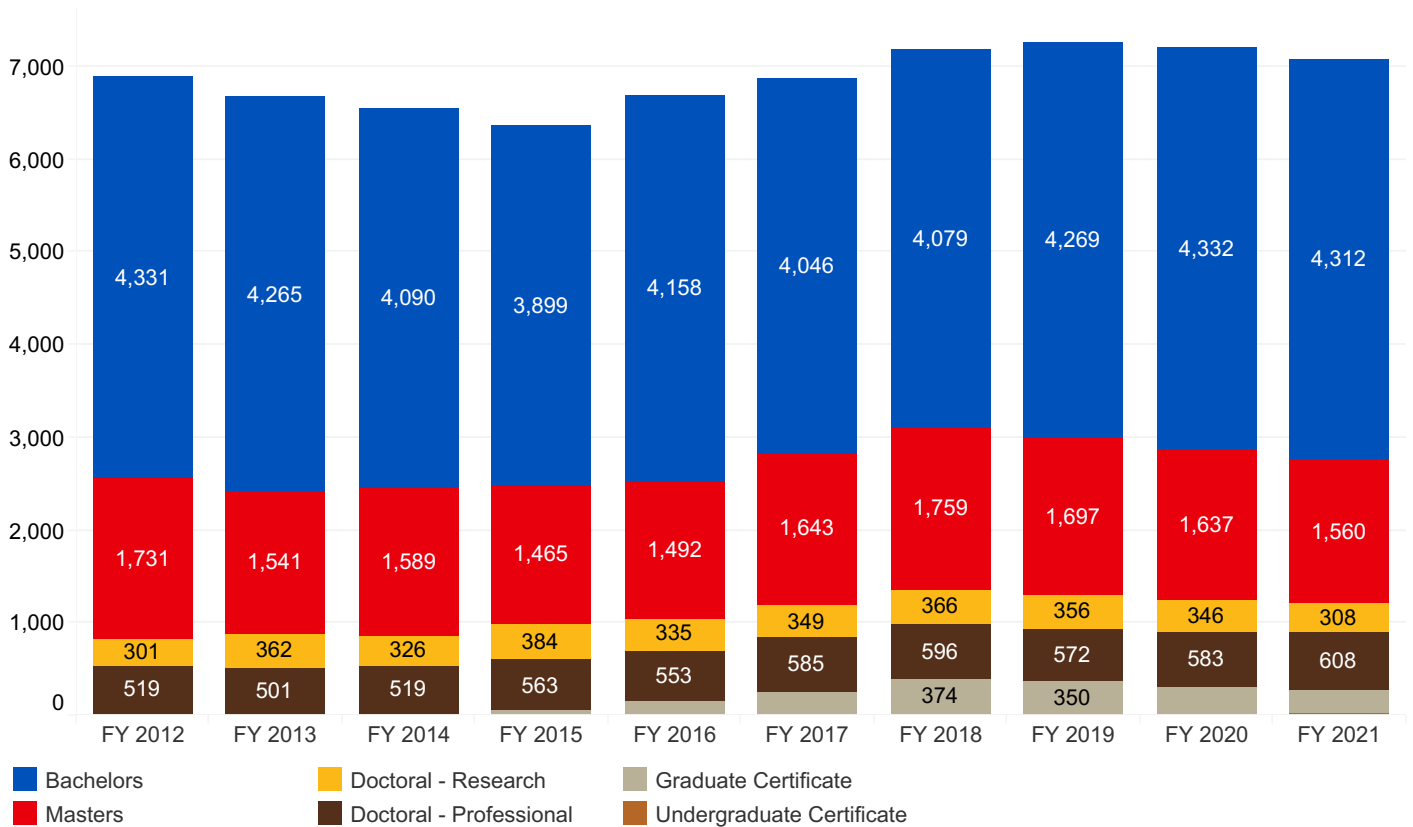



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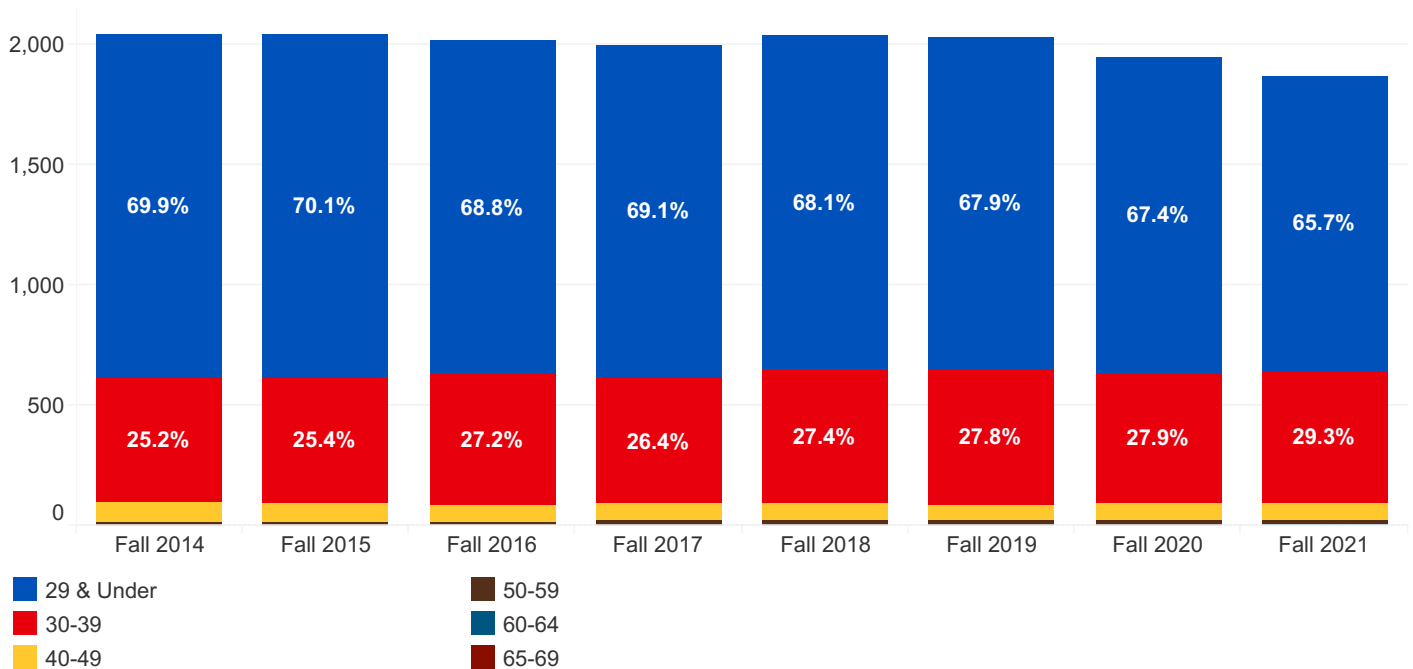

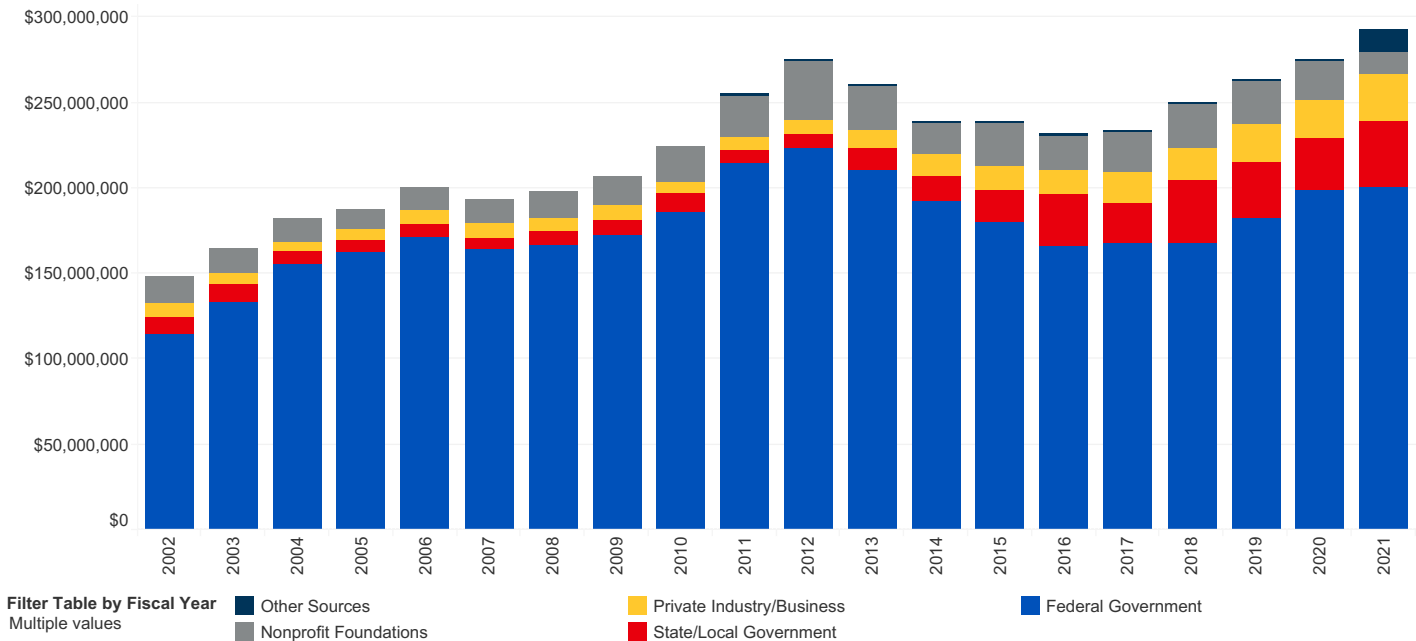
Externally Funded Expenditures for Separately Budgeted Research By Source of Funds

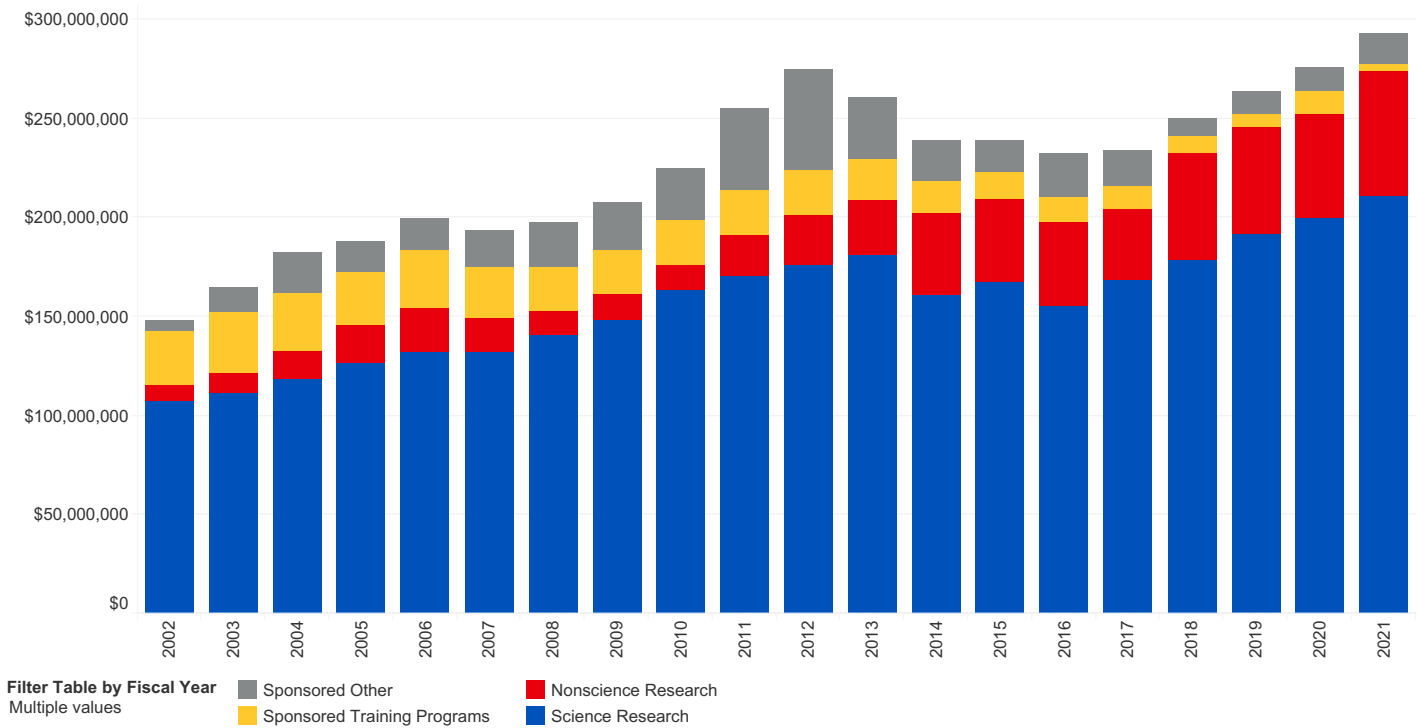

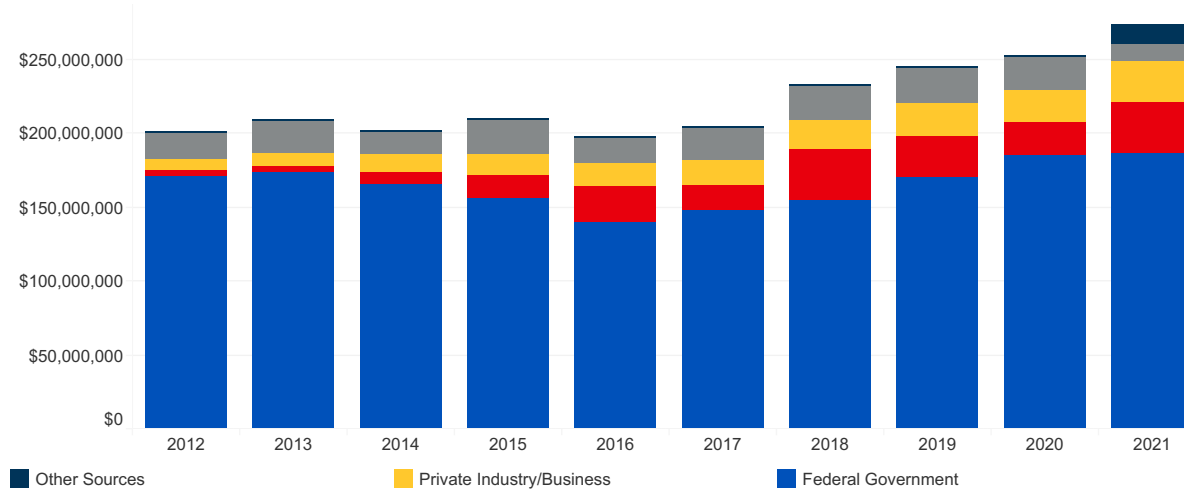

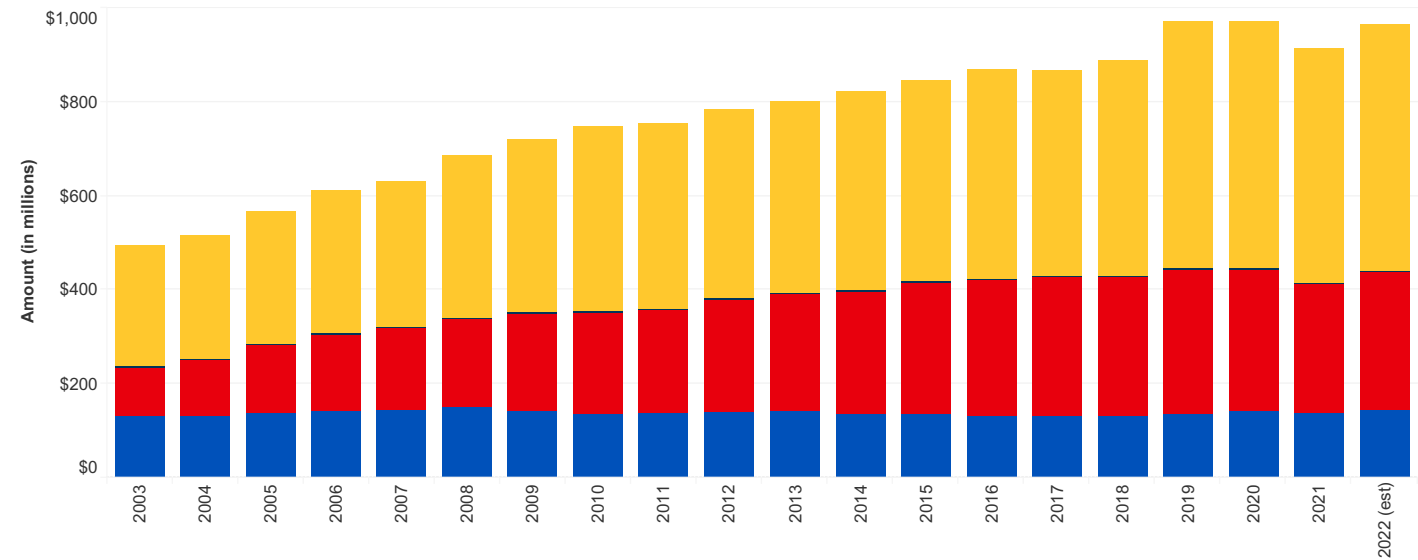
Actual Cash Expenditures by Fund (In Millions of Dollars)

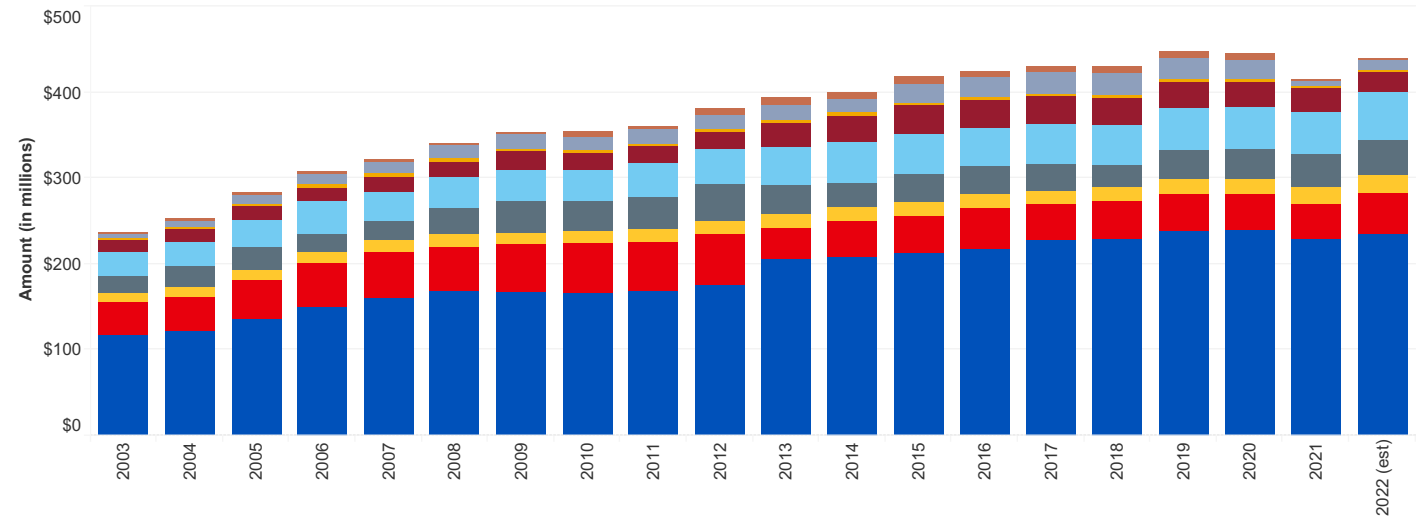

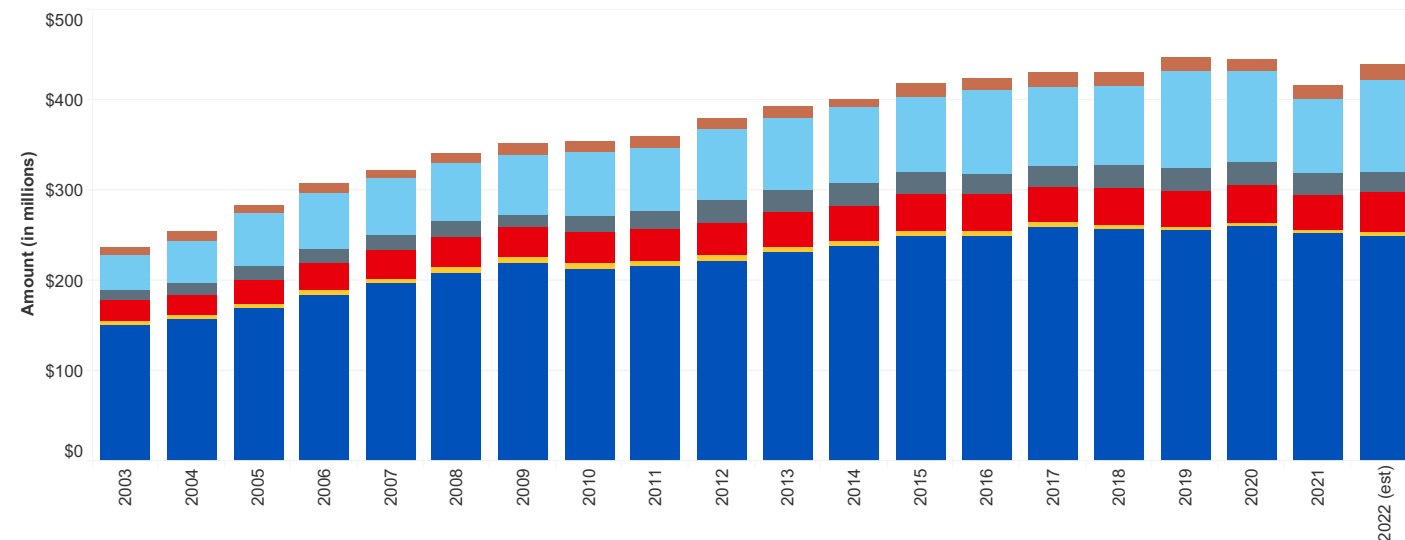
Actual General Use Funds Expenditures by Object (In Millions of Dollars)

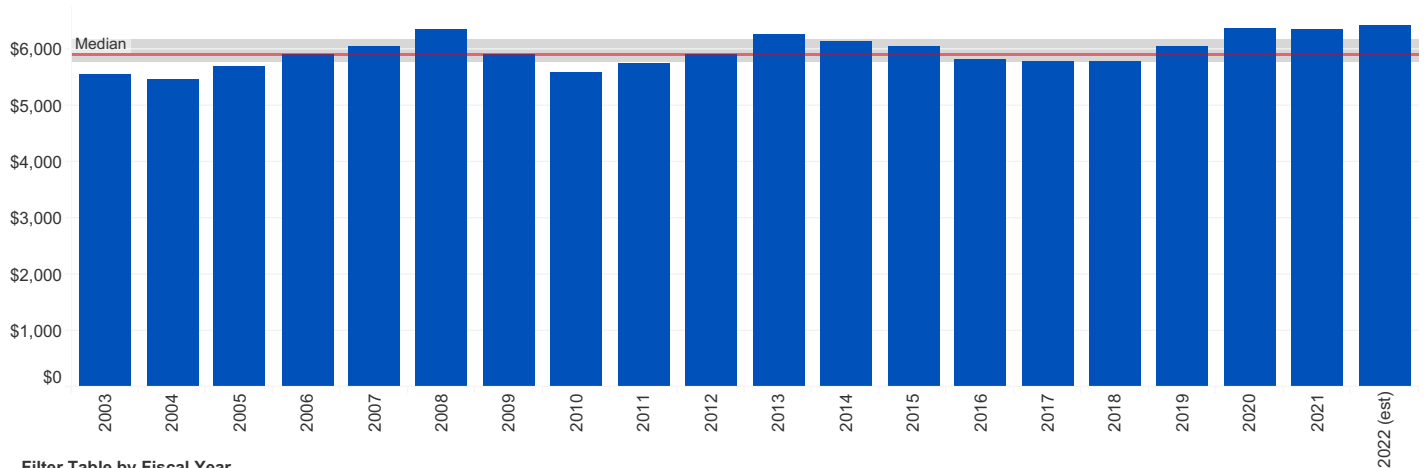

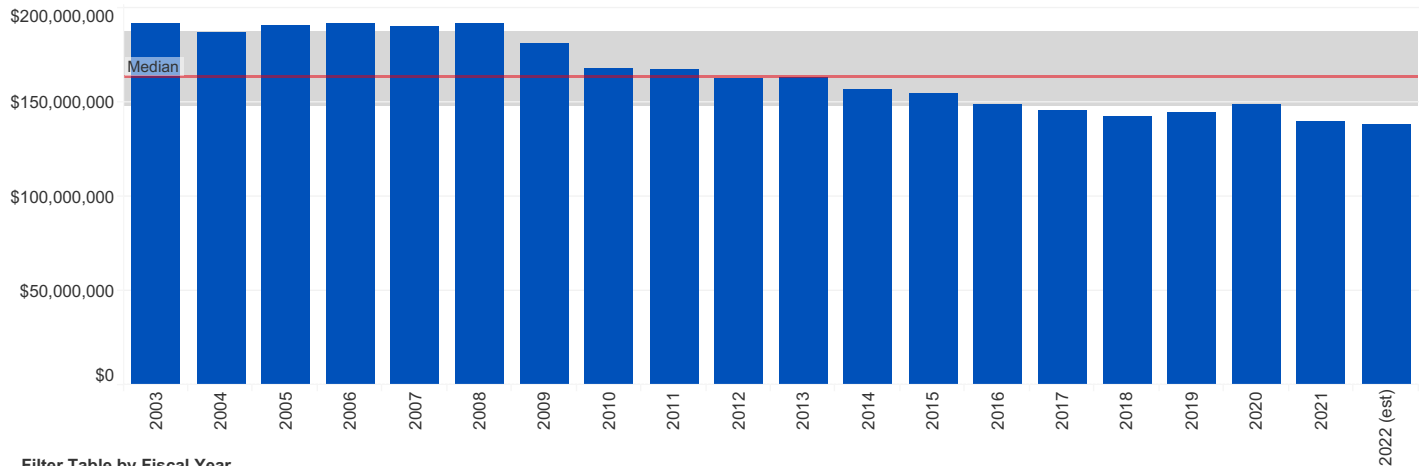

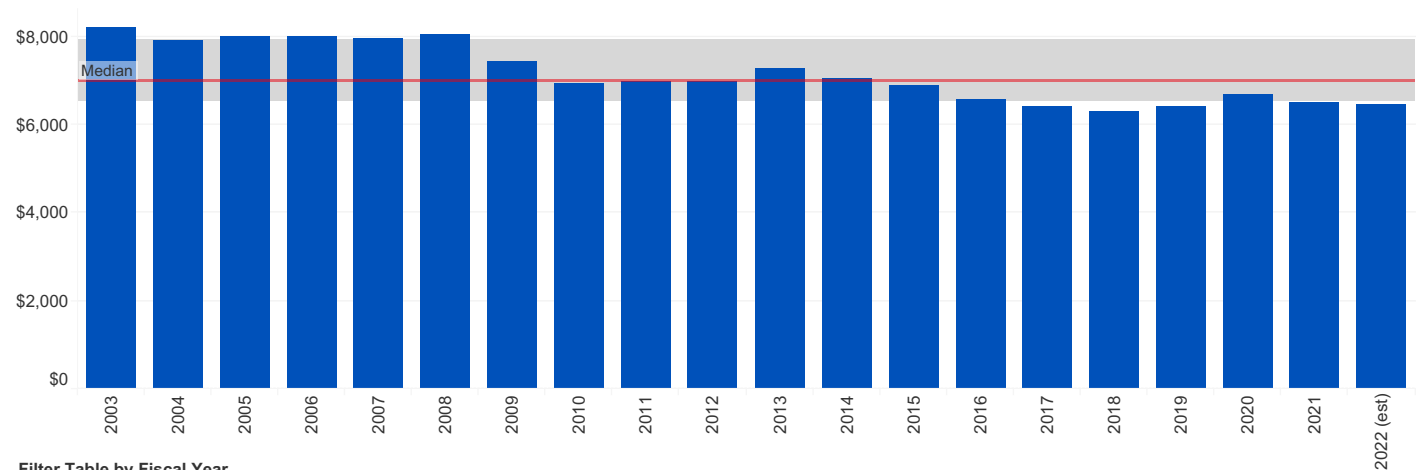

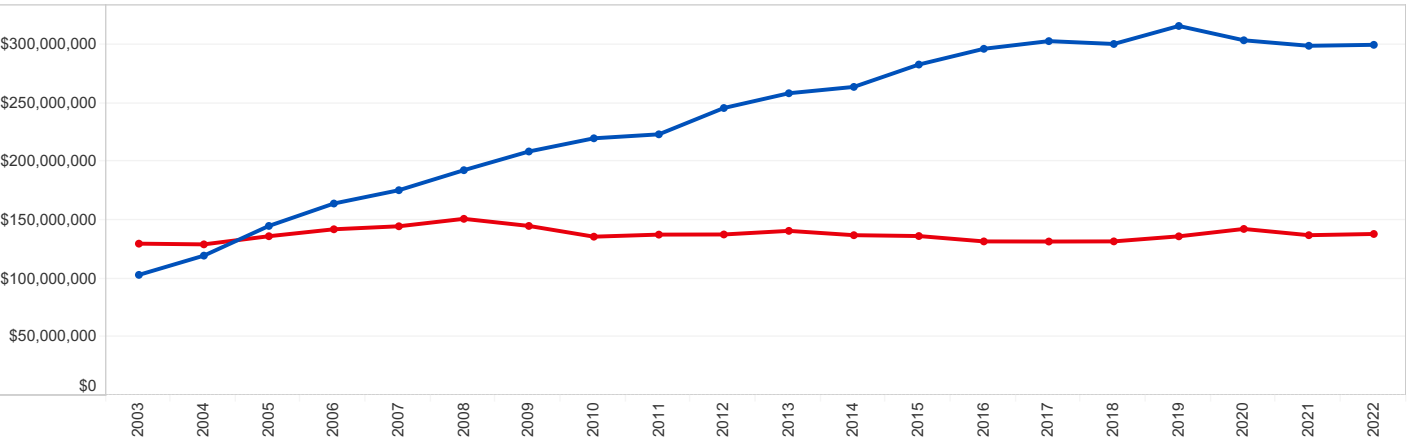

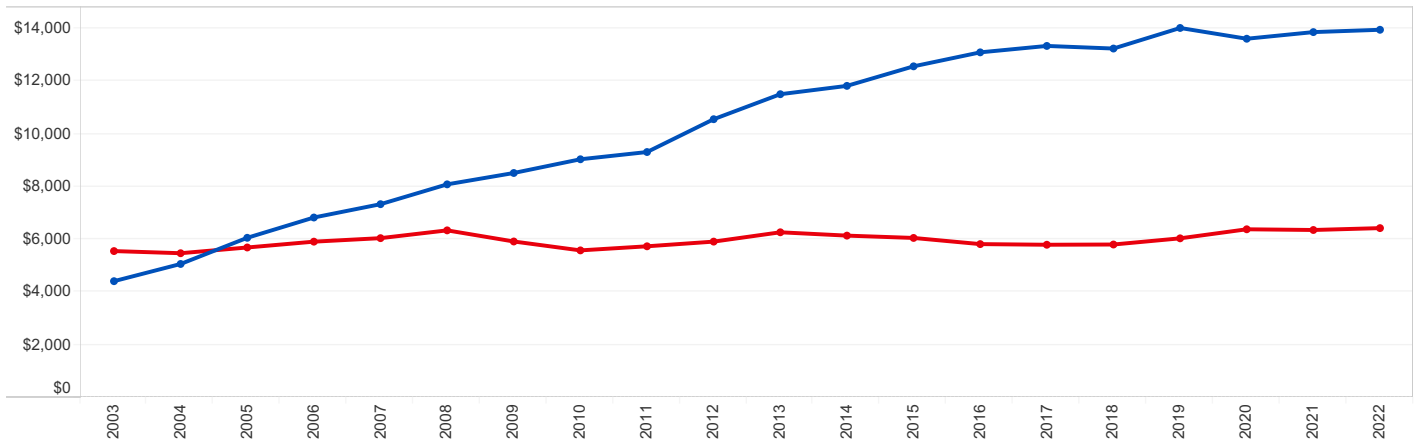

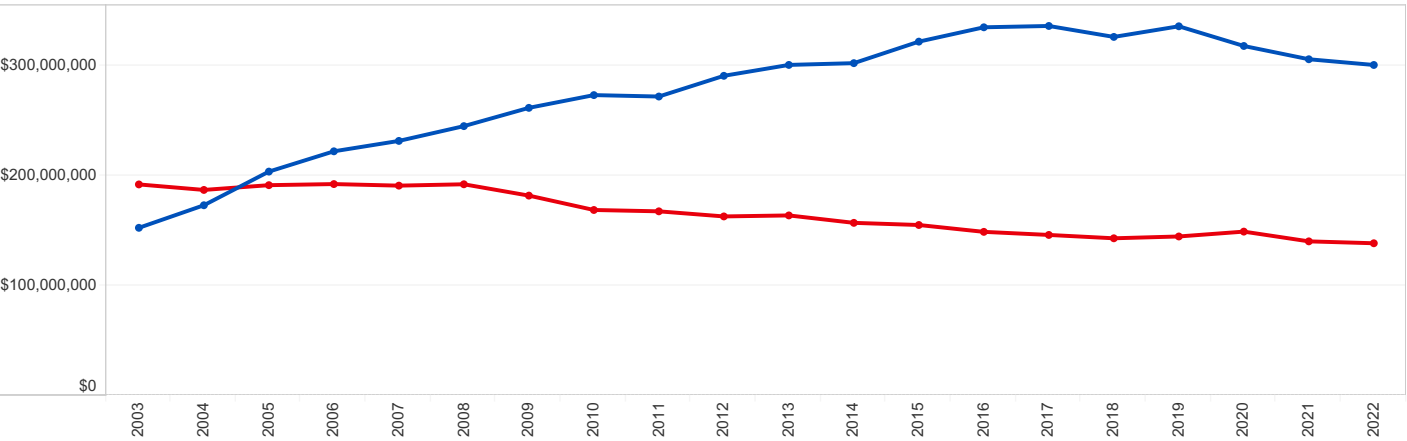

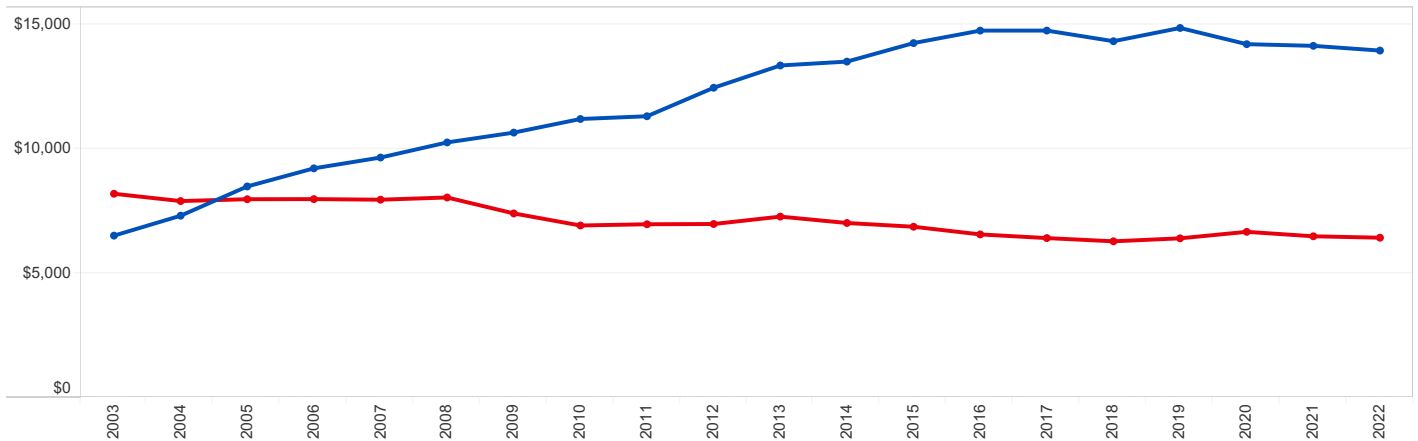
