Fees at the Lawrence Campus also include the infrastructure fee and course fees. The weighted average College of Liberal Arts & Sciences course fees are used for the undergraduate and graduate fees while the relevant course fees listed below are used for the Pharmacy and Law fees.

** Beginning in Fall 2023, the PharmD compact tuition rate is no longer offered to incoming students. Students who entered the PharmD program prior to Fall 2023 will continue to pay the flat semester rates set by their tuition compact which includes all tuition and fees. For students who entered between Fall 2020 and Fall 2022, the annual resident tuition rate is \$23,420 and the annual nonresident tuition rate is \$43,250.

*** Medicine tuition is a set annual rate.
